Motion made by (SH) seconded by (BC) to accept Warrant #43; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (RB) to approve Property Tax Abatements and a Supplemental tax bill; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (RB) seconded by (BC) to appoint Sherri Thornton, Megan O'Brien, Wanda O'Brien, Bethany O'Brien & Sue King to be on the Bicentennial Committee; vote was unanimous.
