Keith Wing from Plymouth Engineering updated the Board regarding increase in estimated cost for replacement of transfer station building. The Board will check with MMA to determine whether a contract signed in December 2021 will commit 2021 funds even if payments are made during 2022. The Board will follow up with Keith after consulting MMA.

Brian Levesque updated the Board regarding the status of efforts to repair the town beach. The Board will review the bid package and take the issue up again at the next meeting.
