

# Town of Burnham

Select Board Minutes for  
Monday July 26, 2021

Meeting called to order at 7 pm

Present: S. Huff, R. Basford and 2 others

Motion made by (SH) and seconded by (RB) to approve the meeting minutes of July 12, 2021; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) and seconded by (RB) to approve Warrant #17; vote was unanimous.

## **Appointments:**

(SH) made motion to go into Executive session (RB) seconded to discuss Code enforcement officer matter, (1 M.R.S.A. § 405 (6)(H)); vote was unanimous.

(RB) made motion to end Executive session (SH) seconded; vote was unanimous – it was decided that all after the fact permit fees given by the Planning board need to pay and landowner can appeal through the Appeals board, if they disagree.

Brandy Lane complaint was reviewed for possible junk yard - motion made by (SH) to send a notice of violation, (RB) seconded; vote was unanimous.

## **Old business:**

Brian Levesque finished the revised bid packages for the beach project, date for bids to be received has been changed to Aug. 23, 2021 @ 4:00 PM.

Plymouth Engineering email response was reviewed – the Select board requested we have the Transfer station plans as soon as possible so the project can be put out to bid. Emailed Plymouth Engineering with request.

## **New Business:**

Boston Post Cane letter to Ralph Reynolds has been sent, to be presented Aug. 23, 2021.

The space between the cans at the transfer station needs cleaning, bushhogging and scraping the upper driveway at a cost of \$400, Brent Chase is available to do this job. The Select board agreed to Brent Chase completing bushhogging, awaiting WC Predetermination paperwork.

PDQ (Dave, owner) states he has found the parts, being shipped, should have them in and repairs completed by end of next week. If repairs are not completed, the Select board requested we go with the second door company Charlie K. has spoken with.

Transfer Station closure complaints – R. Basford has spoken with Shenia & S. Huff has spoken with Mike. Mike Bolster states this will not happen again. Dump attendant has been told to pile trash on the ground if both canisters are full.

Covid vaccination site – The Select Board has agreed to have Drexell White & the Public health nurses come in on Aug 9, 2021, to do a site visit and answer any questions we may have regarding hold a Covid vaccination site here at the Town Office.

Upcoming tax due dates –

2019 tax liens come due May 2022

2020 tax liens come due November 2022

2021 taxes go to lien May 2022, come due November 2023

2022 tax bills mailed end of July 2022

Regarding the upcoming tax due dates, The Select Board agreed with S King, that the Treasurer is to send a letter to the residents still owing 2019 taxes as to what 2022 will look like regarding taxes still owed.

Regarding the Town website – select board agreed to pay yearly for website renewal.
