Select Board Minutes for  
Monday, April 29, 2024

Meeting called to order 7:00 PM.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (RB) to accept the April 15, 2024, select board minutes; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (RB) to accept Warrant # 17 Payroll; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (BC) to accept Warrant # 18; vote was unanimous.

The MSAD #53 school board met with the select board to discuss the proposed school budget. The public-school meeting will be held Tuesday, May 21 in the Warsaw Gym and the district vote will be held Tuesday, June 7<sup>th</sup> in each town.

Angela Wren, Doug Chadwick, Roger & Allyson Chadwick discussed Parsons Lane with the select board on whether to pursue discontinuing or fixing Parsons Lane. A mutual agreement was reached between all parties to sign an agreement to close Parsons Lane with barricades from November 1<sup>st</sup> through May 1<sup>st</sup>, to keep the snowplows and traffic off the road, to prevent further damage to the road.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (RB) to reimburse a resident for the \$25.00 transfer station fee for construction debris, due to stopping the allowance of construction debris in January 2024; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (BC) to appoint Randall Hall as Plumbing Inspector; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (BC) to approve the supplement tax bills; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (RB) to sign the Memorandum of Lease for July 18, 2024, through July 21, 2024, between Brian Kenney and the Town of Burnham for the Bicentennial celebration; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) seconded by (RB) to allow Pride Manufacturing space at the Transfer station to drop off donated wood for residents to pick up, during open Transfer station hours; vote was unanimous.
