Select Board Minutes for  
Monday, May 16, 2022

Present: R. Basford, S. Huff, B. Chase, and four others

Meeting called to order 7:00 PM.

Motion made by (SH) and seconded by (BC) to accept May 9, 2022, Select Board minutes; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) and seconded by (BC) to pay Warrant # 12; vote was unanimous.

The Select board requested an email be sent to RJD Assessors inquiring about doing a Factor Revaluation, we are still waiting for a response from RJD.

The Select board discussed Bolster's Rubbish invoice that included a fuel charge of \$35.00 per trip. No action taken.

Motion made by (SH) and seconded by (BC) to hire RC King & Sons to spend up to \$3000.00 to fix the Transfer Station roadway; vote was unanimous.

The administrative assistant advised the Select board of the following:

- The property owner of the vacant lot with the camper hooked up has called the plumbing inspector for a plumbing & occupancy permit.
- The Transfer station new orange stickers are in and available at the Town office. The blue stickers are now invalid.
- The Transfer station project is complete and approved by Plymouth Engineering. Ralph McNaughton Construction has submitted his final invoice to be paid on warrant #12.
- Charlie Porter and Linda Hunter, temporary Health officer, visited the property of a previous complaint and Charlie Porter left a message for the Select board that the dangerous building needs to be condemned. Charlie stated he was calling the property owner to advise.
