**SELECT BOARD MEETING**

July 18, 2019

**8:30 am - PRESENT:** G. Robison, W. Mitchell and 3 others (Charlie King, Ron Tyler & Gary Libby from Maine DOT) at the Mill Bridge on Pond Road

**OLD BUSINESS:** The Board discussed the recent inspection report received from the Dot regarding the Mill Bridge, with Ronald Tyler and Gary Libby. It was determined that repairs would need to be done within the next two years.

- Gary Libby stated that he'd inspected the bridge earlier that week and had downgraded the condition of the bridge to a 3 from a 4 where it was two years ago , which would make it almost condemned.

**9:30 am** – Select Board Meeting continues at the Burnham Town Office

- The Board determines that the next step would be to submit a plan to the state. W. Mitchell made a motion to contact **Plymouth Engineering** for advice and help with submitting a plan, and if interested, to come in to a Board Meeting to discuss. G. Robison seconded. Vote was unanimous. It was agreed to include Charlie King in all parts of the process.

- Regarding the work that needs to be done at the Town Office, there was discussion on considering it three separate jobs (**vault roof, front doors and floors**) with separate quotes for each. A quote from Chris Cook to refinish the Town Office floors was reviewed, which did not include the vault roof or the front doors. G. Robison made a motion to consider these jobs as three separate projects, rather than one. W. Mitchell seconded. Vote was unanimous.

- It was agreed to contact W.B. Mason to return the five gallons of floor polly purchased last January since it would not be used.
