APPOINTMENTS:

OLD BUSINESS: K. Hapworth agreed to attend the Elected Officials Workshop at MMA on Dec. 19, 2019.

- The Board reviewed and discussed a copy of the easement from the Town of Pittsfield to the Town of Burnham for a snowplow turnaround on the Cookson Road. It was agreed to contact Kristin Collins to draft an easement for the snowplow turnaround on the Johnson Flat Road on the land owned by Susan & David Thies.

NEW BUSINESS: Arlene Miles informed the Board of Tax Acquired Property, as of Nov. 23, 2019. It was agreed to contact MMA and Kristin Collins with questions of how to dispose of the older tax acquired property, as well as the newly acquired, since one of the properties included a residence.
