Select Board Minutes for
Monday, November 28, 2022

Meeting called to order 7:00 PM.

Motion made by (SH) and seconded by (BC) to accept November 14, 2022, Select Board minutes; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (SH) and seconded by (BC) to pay Warrant #26; vote was unanimous.

The Unity Public Library sent a letter stating they would like to be added to the 2023 Town of Burnham's budget committee meeting, stating they will be making a request of \$1,096.00 for the 2023 budget year. No action was taken.

The Select board reviewed a request from Efficiency Maine, stating a resident on Young Lane is requesting the Town of Burnham adopt an ordinance to become a PACE (Property Assessed Clean Energy) Town. No action was taken.

Motion made by (SH) and seconded by (BC) to conduct Personnel reviews on Dec. 12, 2022. Vote was unanimous.

The Select board reviewed two complaints:

Transfer Station – parking to unload not being utilized properly

Roads – N. Horseback Rd was slippery between Twitchell's Corner & Basford Rd.
