Please verify this issue, we are providing 100% correct information on our village problem. We are sitting around 65 homes in the entire board area. Every night lots of people come here to play Andhar Bahar. The whole night drunk players fight together and use bad language. We are always harassed sir, it's a very bad message to our children. Even after the evening, our children are scared to walk in our area. We are still surprised that the Nakashipara police station inspector Shri Biplob Karmakar (+91 9147888216) did not stop the Illegal Board when lots of problems faced every village people. Local Police know that seniors do not STOP them from doing anything they are doing illegally. Imagine how much audacity and anti-social activity is being carried out Bethua Khalpar Gambling Board run by Mr. Anisul Halsana (+91 8101161583) / Mr. Dipankar Bairagya nicknamed Ghona (+91 7001134801) / Mr. Gautam Bairagya (+91 9734976946). But we are now losing confidence in the current government's actions.
