CG Jung thought that modern man had lost his way fragmenting into a calloused and threadbare individualism on the one hand and the mass-mindedness of an impersonal state on the other. Between this hardened individualism and desolate political system, the religious instinct has been lost or worse, harnessed to the authoritarianism of populist movements. The results are catastrophic. Political polarization, climate change, the severe wealth divide and other social and economic injustices, the collapse of communities of belonging and the subsequent epidemic of loneliness, these are the multiple crises of our time.
