This Privacy Policy describes how NOASCOPE or SCOPE by NOABIO (the "Site" or "Software" or "App" or "we") collects, uses, and discloses your Personal Information when you visit or make a purchase.

Collecting Personal Information

When you visit the Site, we collect certain information about your device, your interaction with the Site, and information necessary to process your purchases. We may also collect additional information if you contact us for customer support. In this Privacy Policy, we refer to any information that can uniquely identify an individual (including the information below) as "Personal Information". See the list below for more information about what Personal Information we collect and why.

Device information

- Examples of Personal Information collected: version of web browser, IP address, time zone, cookie information, what sites or products you view, search terms, and how you interact with the Site.
- **Purpose of collection:** to load the Site accurately for you, and to perform analytics on Site usage to optimize our Site.
- **Source of collection:** Collected automatically when you access our Site using cookies, log files, web beacons, tags, or pixels, Facebook surveys etc.
- **Disclosure for a business purpose:** shared with our processors like Shopify/Website, Facebook and google for advertisement purposes only.

Order information

- Examples of Personal Information collected: name, email address, payment information and phone number.
- **Purpose of collection:** to provide products or services to you to fulfill our contract, to process your payment information, arrange for shipping, and provide you with invoices and/or order confirmations, communicate with you, screen our orders for potential risk or fraud, and when in line with the preferences you have shared with us, provide you with information or advertising relating to our products or services.
- **Source of collection:** collected from you.
- **Disclosure for a business purpose:** shared with our processors like Website, Facebook and google for advertisement purposes only.

Customer support information

- Examples of Personal Information collected: name, email address and phone number.
- **Purpose of collection:** to provide you with information or advertising relating to our products or services.
- Source of collection: collected from you.
- **Disclosure for a business purpose:** shared with our processors like Website, Facebook and google for advertisement purposes only.

Minors

We do not intentionally collect Personal Information from children. If you are the parent or guardian and believe your child has provided us with Personal Information, please contact us at the address below to request deletion.

Sharing Personal Information

We share your Personal Information with service providers to help us provide our services and fulfill our contracts with you, as described above. For example:

- We may share your Personal Information to comply with applicable laws and regulations, to respond to a subpoena, search warrant or other lawful request for information we receive, or to otherwise protect our rights.
- Similarly, your information may be shared with Facebook and Google for the purposes of marketing and information sharing about our products.

Behavioural Advertising

Using Personal Information

We use your personal Information to provide our services to you, which includes: offering products for sale, processing payments, shipping and fulfillment of your order, and keeping you up to date on new products, services, and offers.

Lawful basis

Pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), if you are a resident of the European Economic Area ("EEA"), we process your personal information under the following lawful bases:

- Your consent:
- Compliance with our legal obligations;
- For our legitimate interests, which do not override your fundamental rights and freedoms.

Retention

When you place an order through the Site, we will retain your Personal Information for our records unless and until you ask us to erase this information. For more information on your right of erasure, please see the 'Your rights' section below.

Automatic decision-making

If you are a resident of the EEA, you have the right to object to processing based solely on automated decision-making (which includes profiling), when that decision-making has a legal effect on you or otherwise significantly affects you.

We *Do* engage in fully automated decision-making that has a legal or otherwise significant effect using customer data.

Services that include elements of automated decision-making include:

- Temporary denylist of IP addresses associated with repeated failed transactions. This denylist persists for a small number of hours.
- Temporary denylist of credit cards associated with denylisted IP addresses. This denylist persists for a small number of days.

Cookies

A cookie is a small amount of information that's downloaded to your computer or device when you visit our Site. This means you don't have to re-enter this information each time you return to the site or browse from one page to another.

The length of time that a cookie remains on your computer or mobile device depends on whether it is a "persistent" or "session" cookie. Session cookies last until you stop browsing and persistent cookies last until they expire or are deleted. Most of the cookies we use are persistent and will expire between 30 minutes and two years from the date they are downloaded to your device.

Changes

Account Deletion

You are entitled to demand that your personal data regarding your person/account is deleted, and the Administrator is obligated to remove the personal data without undue delay if any of the following circumstances take place:

- 1. The personal data is no longer required for the purposes for which it has been collected or processed in another manner;
- 2. You withdraw your consent on which the data processing is grounded and there are no other legal grounds for processing;
- 3. You file an objection against processing of data,
- 4. The personal data was processed in a manner not compliant with the law;

You are entitled to demand that the Administrator limit the processing in the following cases:

- 1. When you question the correctness of your personal data for the period enabling the Administrator to check the correctness of this data;
- 2. When the processing is not compliant with the law and the client objects to deletion of personal data, demanding instead the limitation of its use.
