Selection Criteria:

We are seeking impassioned leaders who have demonstrated a commitment to the growth and success of Lake County. By design, we have limited the class size in order to provide optimal hands-on learning, team building, and networking opportunities. All applications will be reviewed by the Leadership Lake County Board of Regents Selection Committee. Individuals will be selected based on the merits of your application as follows:

- Individuals with excellent potential to play a significant role in the community's future, who have attained a top leadership position within their business or organization, or who have strongly demonstrated a potential for advancement to top leadership positions.
- Individuals who are interested in seeking, or intending to seek public office, boards, commissions, or key volunteer leadership roles
- Individuals who have demonstrated participation and contribution to the Lake County community.
- Individuals who represent a cross-section of all facets of the community.
- Individuals who will commit to a two (2) year involvement (as described below).

Program Commitments:

Leadership Lake County requires a major time commitment from the participants, with full-day programs held 1-2 times a month for nine months (schedule below.) Before you consider participation, we ask that you commit to attendance at LLC programs in their entirety and ensure that you, your employer and family are willing to make a two-year commitment.

Once an applicant has been accepted and has affirmed acceptance, tuition is \$1,300. If paid by August 31, 2021 tuition will be discounted to \$1,050. Tuition is due and payable in full no later than October 1, 2021. All application withdrawals must be received 14 days in advance of first session for refund less \$50 processing fee.

To gradua	ate from the Leadership Lake County program, participants must (please initial each line):
	Attend a MANDATORY OVERNIGHT SIMSOC session. Failure to attend this session is automatic dismissal from
	program. No exceptions.
	Attend MANDATORY Wrap up session.
	Attend all required sessions and conduct themselves in a professional manner. You will be given ample notification prior to each month's class as to the location (with directions) and start time.
	Complete two approved internships (different than participants own industry). Each must be at least 5 hours in length.
	Participants are responsible for arranging their internships. All internship paperwork is due by April 10, 2022.
	Participants missing more than two sessions will be immediately dismissed from the program. Upon dismissal, there
	is no appeal and no refund of tuition.
	Definition of Absences constituting a Session:
	Absence of four (4) hours or more constitutes a full day.
	Absence of less than four (4) hours constitutes a half day.
	Graduation for the Class of 2022 will be scheduled for May 19, 2021. Family & friends are welcome to attend.
	Commit to participation in a class project the second year.
	Attend at least one alumni event in the second year
