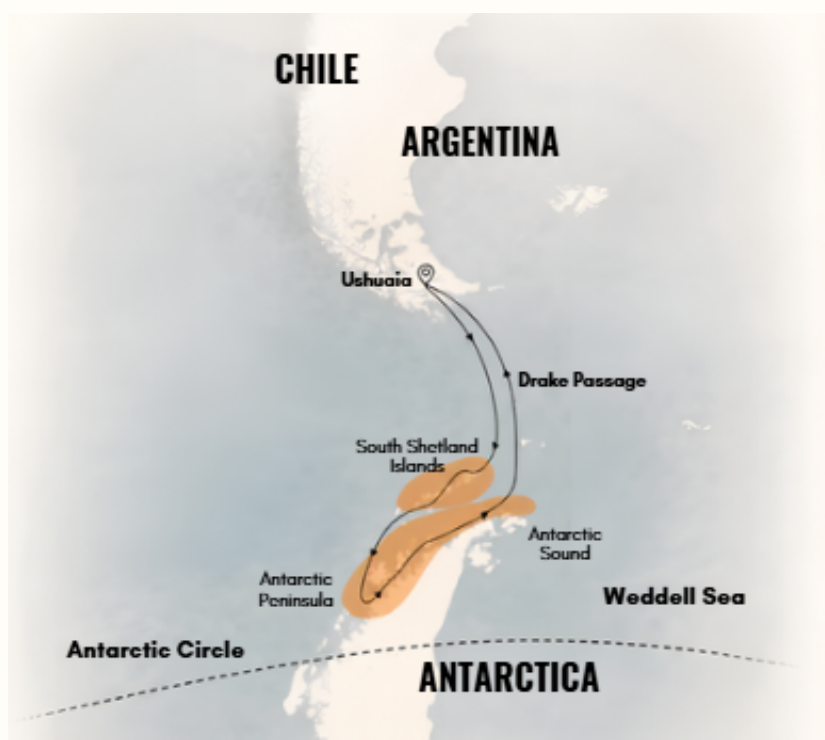

AT A GLANCE

Itinerary summary

- DAY 1** Ushuaia, Argentina
Board the expedition vessel and set off along the Beagle Channel.
- DAY 2-3** Crossing the Drake Passage (Southbound)
Cross the Drake Passage — lectures, wildlife spotting, and your first icebergs.
- DAY 4-8** Exploring the Antarctic Peninsula
The heart of the expedition — landings, wildlife, kayaking, and zodiac cruises.
- DAY 9** Farwell Landings
One final landing before heading back north — Brown Bluff or Paulet Island
- DAY 10** Crossing the Drake Passage (Northbound)
Relive the journey north — final lectures, seabird spotting, and a celebratory dinner.
- DAY 11** Return to Ushuaia
Arrive back in Ushuaia — disembark with stories to last a lifetime.

Day 1

Your adventure begins with boarding The Terra Nova Adventurer at Ushuaia, Argentina where you'll meet your crew and fellow travellers. After settling into your cabin, the ship sets off along the picturesque Beagle Channel. Relish your first evening at sea as the southernmost tip of South America disappears from view.

Day 2 - 3

Start your Antarctic adventure with a crossing of the Drake Passage, a vast stretch of open ocean that marks the Antarctic Convergence, where nutrient-rich waters sustain a vibrant ecosystem.

While at sea, attend expert-led talks on Antarctica's history, wildlife, and geology. Head to the open decks or the bridge to spot albatrosses, petrels, and even whales. Adventure activities, including navigation workshops and safety briefings for kayaking and snowshoeing, will also be held.

By the end of Day 3, the first sighting of icebergs and snow-capped peaks will signal your arrival at the South Shetland Islands.

Day 4 - 8 Exploring the Antarctic Peninsula

The core of the journey unfolds as you explore the Antarctic Peninsula and South Shetland Islands, with each day offering a blend of landings, zodiac cruises, and optional adventure activities: Kayaking Among Icebergs, Snowshoeing Adventures, Penguin Colonies, Wildlife Encounters.

Day 10

Crossing the Drake Passage (Northbound)

Relive your adventures as you cross the Drake Passage, keeping an eye out for seabirds and whales along the way. Take part in final lectures or workshops, and enjoy a celebratory dinner with your fellow travellers as you reflect on the unforgettable journey.

Day 11

Return to Ushuaia

Arrive back in Ushuaia in the early morning. After breakfast, disembark with cherished memories of an epic Antarctic expedition and new stories to tell.

The Terra Nova Adventurer Built for the Southern Ocean Lloyd's Register 1B ice class, 105.5 metres and 6,334 gross tonnes, with retractable stabilisers and a bow thruster. The stabilisers are what you'll be glad of crossing the Drake.

Cabins & suites Sixty-three cabins across six categories, from Discovery Quad to Premium Suite, with dedicated Superior Single cabins for solo travellers. Interiors upgraded in 2019 and refurbished again in 2026.

Onboard facilities Restaurant, spa, sauna, gym and an outdoor jacuzzi across five passenger decks. A library and lecture lounge for the expedition team's talks, a heated mudroom for landings, and a drink at Birdie Bowers, named for the man who walked to the Pole with Scott.
