Located on Pine Creek, at the base of Black Mountain, 40 miles from Yellowstone, Luccock Park is an outstanding facility for all people to enjoy. Youth camps, wedding parties, family reunion groups, spiritual retreats, women's groups, leadership academies, team retreats, arts, music and crafter's groups have all called Luccock home for a night, a weekend, a week or longer. Supported by the UMC Mountain Sky Conference, Luccock operates as a people's park and we hope to host you soon.

Luccock is a rustic camp, with 60-year-old cabins, which are disconnected from today's hectic pace. Come to enjoy the quiet, hike the hills and enjoy God's splendor. We welcome campers of all shapes, sizes and affiliations. Ask us about wedding and reunion options as well as retreats and camps. Our grounds are filled with wildlife and nature's glory. Pets are allowed in very limited situations, in order to preserve these facts. Come prepared to be awed.

Situated at the base of Black Mountain with a nine-acre meadow, Luccock is a true paradise in Paradise Valley.





The three towering mountains are fondly named Faith, Hope and Charity, which are values we hold dear here at Luccock.

Chico Hot Springs is 12 miles down the road, and Livingston is 17 miles to the north and the road is paved right to our gate. Still, you will feel like you are in the middle of nowhere when you are here.





Meal times are 8a, 12p,5p Quiet Hours are 10p – 8a Unless otherwise noted in your contract.

We serve over 10,000 meals each summer and boast well water that is pristine and delicious, for your drinking pleasure.

#### MONEY FAQS

- Deposits or one-half total wedding/reunion fees are required at the time of signing contract.
- **Deposits are refundable** if event is canceled up to 120 days prior. After 119 days deposit is non-refundable.
- Camp/event hosts are expected to collect payments from their guests and remit to Luccock in a lump sum balance, unless other arrangements have been stated in the contract.
- Balance is due two weeks prior to event, when the Go Form is submitted to the camp manager.
- Additional guests or services will be invoiced and paid for on the last day of the event.
- Wedding and Family Reunion Damage Deposits – \$500.00 due at time of signing; deposit will be applied toward the final bill. If damage is incurred the deposit is forfeited by the payee and you may be subject to further charges.
- Miscellaneous Any other fees incurred will be discussed and agreed upon by both Luccock Park and the event payee. Please designate one person to communicate and approve any additions or changes.
- Our Snack Canteen is open a minimum of 2 hours per day. Stocked with essentials and goodies, this can be a fun experience for your guests. Please let us know if some hours are better than others.

All events are expected to carry a 1-million-dollar insurance policy listing Luccock as the insured.

## General FAQ

**Will we have exclusive use of Luccock?** Events with greater than 60 guests may request exclusive use of Luccock. Because we are a seasonal camp, volunteers may be onsite working on various projects during your event.

**Special Dietary needs:** Our kitchen is equipped to handle vegetarian, vegan, gluten free, dairy free, diets. <u>if</u> we are alerted to them on the Go Form. it is a good idea to bring supplemental food for restrictive diets and intensive allergy needs to supplement our varied choices A small refrigerator is available in the lodge for these meals. **State Law mandates that no outside food be placed or prepared in our kitchen.** 

What ratio of staff to campers do you require? <u>Remember</u>, you and your group are responsible for the safety of your guests, and any damage they cause.

**May we bring our pets?** Each event may have up to two pets in attendance, if approved in your contract. <u>These</u> <u>pets may not be in the meadow, cabins, or dining hall, but are permitted in the parking area.</u> <u>Pets must be leashed</u> <u>at all times, and may not harass the wildlife or humans</u>; animals who break this rule must leave camp immediately. Your party will be accessed \$100 for any and each feces clean-up.

**May we decorate the Hall?** Yes! You may decorate as long as you remember to undecorate. We charge a minimum of \$350 for any clean up our staff has to preform, outside of the ordinary, in the hall, cabins or bathhouses.

**May our guests have liquor?** NO. We do allow up to two beer or wine drinks per guests at weddings, but hard alcohol is prohibited at Luccock. If you will have over 50 guests, we do require that you to have a TIPS certified and licensed caterer doing the serving.

**Dances?** You are welcome to have a dance with a live band or DJ. Outdoor music must end at 9:45 pm, and indoor music ends at 11 pm, in consideration of our neighbors and staff.

Parking: There is no driving or parking on the meadow. Guests need to park at the east end of camp.

**Plumbing:** We have two bathhouses with state of the art on demand water heaters, as well as two restrooms in the main lodge. The Allen cabin has a full ADA bathroom. Yes, we do have outhouses if you want that kind of experience.

**The Creek:** the creek in front of the cabins is great for dipping your toes, but not drinking, as there is a camp above us on the stream. Pine Creek, to the north of camp is available for quiet reflection. Fishing is catch and release only.

Our goal is to provide a memorable event, in a beautiful and safe setting. Please let us know if you have additional needs or questions.
