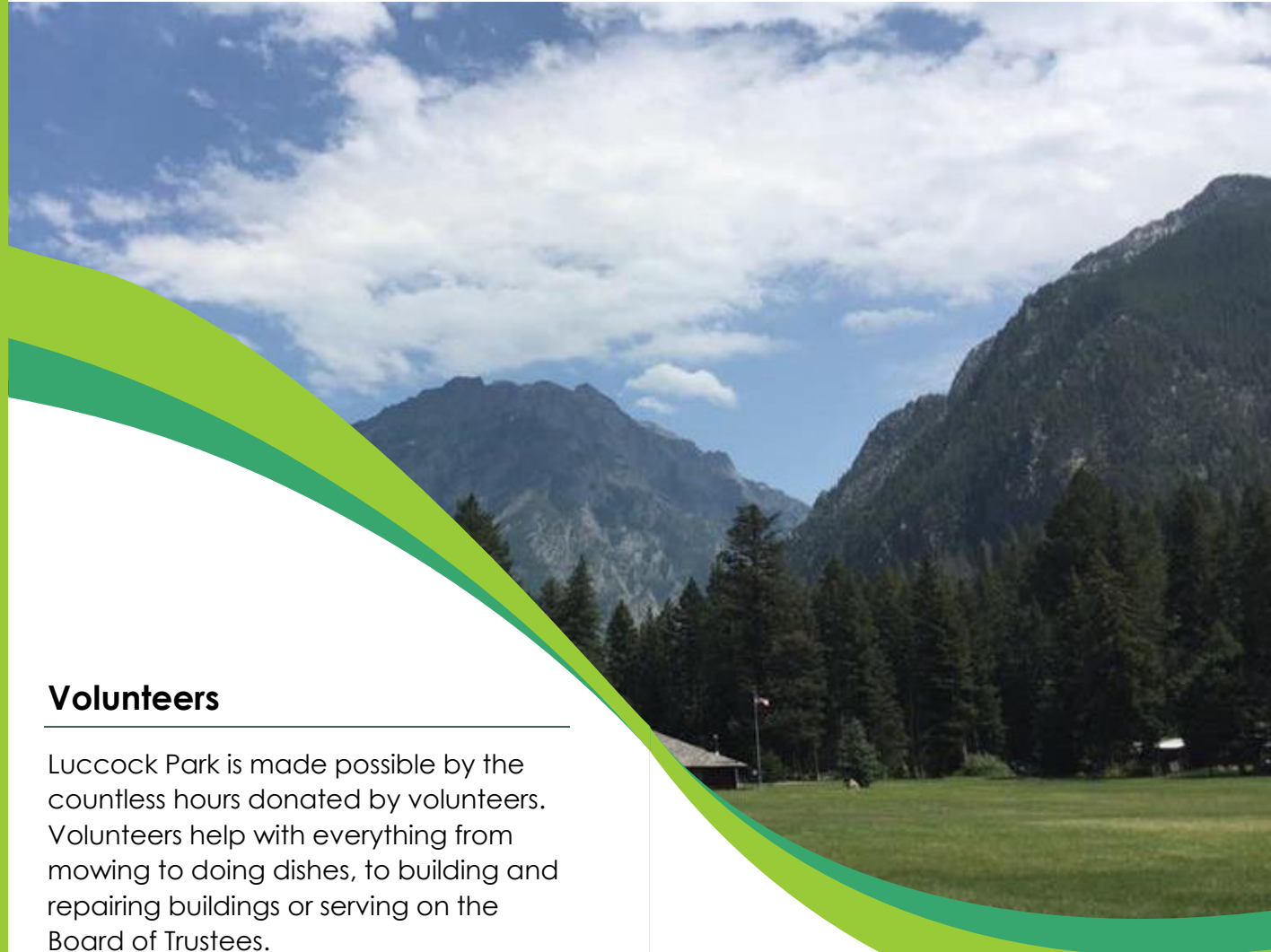
Volunteers
