## AFGC FMZ Councils

AFGC has seats on FMZ councils 9, 10, 13/14, and together we are working on initiatives for our area.

Zone 9: AFGC continues to work with OFHA and MNRF to establish a community hatchery for stocking the St. Mary's River and Lake Superior to benefit sports anglers and tourism.

Zone 10: AFGC has voiced and been heard on new put and take Lakes, including the two new trophy lakes. AFGC was instrumental in the introduction of Aurora trout to the area. The AFGC is actively working on opposing proposed regulation changes to the current walleye limits for 2024.

Zone 13/14 council has reviewed collected data and is recommending some changes to regulations for 2024 or 2025. Proposed changes and options will go through public consultation, however no date has been released.

In the late summer of 2022, the dredging of the ramp and launch area at Harmony beach kicked off along with some much-needed updates to the docks as well.

AFGC organized the Help Us Feed The Deer campaign, along with the assistance of OFAH Zone D and Rack Stacker, in order to help feed deer surviving a challenging winter. Our AFGC Member and volunteer teams collected cedar tree boughs donated from caring citizens and a logging yard, and distributed them to designated deer feeding areas. 300 bags of Rack Stacker Deer Feed was ordered and distributed to Point Louise and the Desbarats area.
