



Feeding Regime Procedure Rev 01

To comply with the Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities Involving Animals) Regulations 2018, we have policies and procedures in place to ensure all dogs are fed a suitable diet, properly hydrated and their feeding and drinking is monitored. All care is taken to ensure food, water and feeding and drinking vessels are clean and free from contamination

- A feeding regime will be agreed with the owners of each dog and written on the booking form.
- Food and water intake will be monitored for the duration of the dogs stay. Any issues will be recorded and monitored, Advice will be sought if required from a professional or the owners emergency contact.
- Clean water will always be readily available both in and outdoors for each dog, this will be regularly changed for fresh.
- Should the owner or emergency contact not be available advice will be sought from their vet and if not available our vet. Permission forms signed on booking in form.
- Details of the vet and their advice will be supplied to the owner on pick up of the dog.
- Feeding and drinking receptacles will be supplied by the owners, if not the ones we use are non-porous, nonslip and stainless-steel
- Receptacles will be cleaned daily and disinfected once a week or on change over whichever happens first.
- Dry food will be stored in a container and when fed to the do not left out for more than 24 hours.
- Uneaten wet food is to be removed before the next feeding time and the bowl cleaned before re use.
- All dry and wet food will be stored at manufacturer's instructions, A separate refrigerator is available if required.
- All food will be stored away in a secure location so vermin and dogs cannot get to it.
- Food preparation will be carried out on clean dry surfaces and utensils used.



- There will be hot and cold water for hand washing and hand drying facilities supplied in the preparation area, with suitable drainage.
- All dogs will be fed separately in different rooms
