



Supporting the needs of dogs under one year

To comply with the Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities Involving Animals) Regulations 2018, we have policies and procedures in place for dogs under one year. We work with them to support their development needs and welfare and document our process.

- Accommodation in an appropriate area, away from other dogs in a quiet, secure area to allow sleep and rest.
- Regular interaction and play more attendance to play, toileting and resting needs. Dependant on the needs and age of the puppy.
- Help to teach interaction with people, Introduce to visitors, delivery and postal workers, neighbours and other dog walkers
- Teach interaction with other dogs, help Introduce to other dogs boarding at establishment, other dogs on walks and neighbour's dogs.
- Teach interaction to other species, Introduce to horses and observation of cattle and sheep and wild animals whilst out walking and general day to day meeting. ie. walks.
- Support of introduction to normal day occurrences, slow and gentle introduction where necessary, ie. Household equipment such as vacuum cleaners, mops, washing machines, tumble driers, hosepipes and brooms. As well as toys and possibly agility equipment.
- Assist where asked to maintain the dogs training like puppy classes, behaviour and walk training.
