 The coral that lies beneath the waves

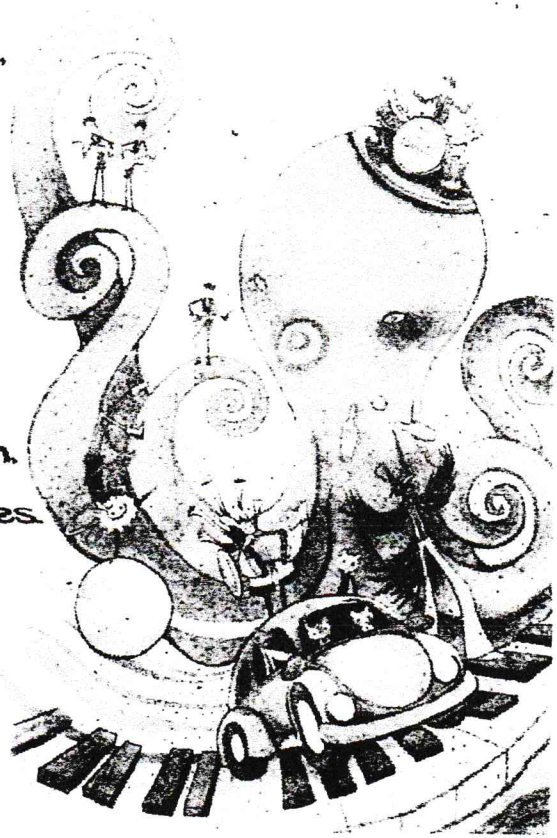
C Oh, what joy, for every girl and boy, <sup>Am</sup> (lies beneath the ocean waves)
