

A POORLY-ORGANIZED FOLDER



- 1. Loose sheets, not hole-punched.
- 2. No file dividers.
- 3. Some sheets in polypockets, some not.

NB. Generally my recommendation is not to bother with polypockets: simply hole-punch sheets instead.

A WELL-ORGANIZED FOLDER



- 1. All sheets hole-punched.
- 2. Sheets in sections, with file dividers.
- 3. Cover sheet with section contents.

NB. You can make your own cover sheet if you like. Alternatively I have some prepared for GCSE / A-level etc.

A well-organized folder can be a hugely valuable resource. Get it organized, then keep it that way!
