



## ConnectMyHealth: Acceptable Identity Documents

The following presents the acceptable types of identity documents associated with ConnectMyHealth account registration. Identity documentation must be valid at the time of account/access request; expired documentation will not be accepted.

## **Preferred Identification**

- 1. Driver's License issued by a Canadian Province or Territory (including graduated Driver's License)
- 2. Ontario Photo Card
- 3. Government-Issued Passport

## Other Types of Acceptable Identification

- 1. Birth Certificate issued by a Canadian Province or Territory
- 2. Canadian Certificate of Birth Abroad
- 3. Canadian Certificate of Indian or Metis Status
- 4. Canadian Permanent Resident Card
- 5. Certificate of Canadian Citizenship
- 6. Certification of Naturalization
- 7. Citizenship Identification Card issued by a foreign jurisdiction where these exist (e.g., Mexico, Europe)
- 8. Confirmation of Permanent Resident (IMM 5292)
- 9. CANPASS
- 10. Nexus
- 11. Firearm Registration License
- 12. Permanent Resident Card (i.e., Maple Leaf Card)
- 13. Statement of Live Birth from Canadian Province (Certified Copy)
- 14. Immigration Canada Refugee Claimant ID Document
