



"What does criticizing our bodies have to do with climate change?"

## History

In 2023, we became the world's first known organization to use somatic movement to address clothing overconsumption.

Whereas many projects have already pronounced fast fashion a climate change villain, we bring home how that villain is connected to our inner selves.

Many of us judge our bodies harshly and hope that clothes will solve for the voids or surpluses our bodies supposedly have. Can all the clothes-buying end, if we are not first satisfied with ourselves? What does criticizing our bodies have to do with climate change?

To address these questions, we made a film funded largely by the National Geographic Society and Kickstarter backing and screened it at The Projector, Singapore, with funds from the Singapore Ministry of Sustainability and the Environment. Our screenings come with somatic movement sessions that invite the audience to consider these questions themselves.

Two Glasses LLP — better known as "Two Glasses" — tackles environmental issues in multidisciplinary ways, believing that silos do more harm that good. The studio was co-founded by Thammika Songkaeo and Tan Xin You in January 2023, and has already been mentioned in Singapore's Parliamentary Sitting.

A recipient of the Ministry of Sustainability and the Environment's SG Eco Fund, the company produced Changing Room in Singapore using a grant from the National Geographic Society, a successful Kickstarter campaign, and private funding. After Bangkok, Changing Room will activate in Tokyo and Zurich in 2025.
