He's been a firefighter, Engineer and Captain of the RMF to become supervisor of local field operations. He is certified by the State of Oregon as a NFPA Fire Officer III, and currently holds a lead position on the Rogue Valley Incident Management Team as an Operations Section Chief. To say this man knows how things work, is an understatement.

His involvement doesn't stop there. He served as Chair of the Josephine County 911 Technical Advisory Committee, Rogue Valley Fire Chiefs Association, the Rogue Interagency Training Association, and as a Fire Defense Board Chief for the Oregon State Fire Marshal's Office. For the 15,000 residential properties contained within a 350-square mile area surrounding the city limits of Grants Pass, fire protection is provided solely through private businesses instead of by tax-funded services. Rural Metro Fire began operations in this area as 'Valley Fire Service' in 1979 to provide fire & rescue services to the residents living in this predominately suburban and rural area.

The community needs to stay informed, learn the facts in the fight for who will protect the residents of the county. This election is crucial for the voters to decide which fire protection they want, because it will be a decision we all live with for many years to come.


