## Julian Ridlen AIM High Park 2024 Park Rules

The park rules are in place to help ensure that all visitors to the Julian Ridlen AIM High Park have a safe and enjoyable experience.

- 1. No field usage without prior authorization. All field usage must have prior approval and must be utilized at the assigned field for the scheduled time slot.
  - \* Scheduling a field may be done by calling or texting the park director: 574-398-7011

## 2. Pets

- Pets are not allowed on the softball fields.
- Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Pet owners are required to clean up pet droppings.
- If a pet is found to show aggression or pose a risk to the safety of others, management reserves the right to request that you remove the pet from the park.
- 3. Bicycles, hoverboards, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters, including electric scooters, roller shoes, etc., are not allowed at the park.
  - Only devices necessary for mobility purposes are allowed; wheelchairs, walkers, electric scooters, etc.

## 4. Trash Disposal

- No littering all trash should be disposed of in the trash receptacles.
- All coaches and athletes should make sure that all trash is removed from the dugout areas at the end of their practice/game.
- 5. Smoking/vaping is *only* allowed in the parking lot area.
  - Smoking/vaping is not allowed near the softball fields, bleachers, pavilion areas, playground, or concessions.
- 6. Profanity or disruptive/aggressive behavior will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the park.
- 7. No promotional items are to be distributed or displayed without prior approval.
- 8. No sales of merchandise, food, beverages, or services without prior approval.
- 9. Gas grills, charcoal grills, smokers, or any such food preparation equipment, for personal or team usage, are not permitted on the property.
- 10. The area where the greenhouses and red barns are located is completely off limits to visitors.
