Entry Fees

Early Entries - prior to March 10.

Junior Show

Any person under the age of 21(as of Jan 1, 2020) may enter the junior show.
Junior cattle may also be shown in the open show.

Steers

All steers must be de-horned and castrated. Steers will be separated into classes by weight. The number of classes will be determined after weigh-in.
Top two steers from each class will compete for Grand and Reserve Champion.

Heifers

Heifers will be separated into classes by birth date and shown youngest to oldest. Top two heifers from each class will compete for Grand and Reserve Champion.

Prizes

Open Champions – Jackpot Cash Prize

Junior Champion & Reserve – Champion Prizes

*All junior exhibitors will receive a prize

General Rules and Information

1. The show will be held under the management of the Lakeland College Stockman's Club.
2. The show is open to all, but the Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
3. The Committee in charge reserves the right to decide on any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary alterations in the Rules and Prize List.
4. All animals being exhibited must be halter-broken and must be securely tied or in the charge of a competent person. No animals shall be allowed to remain loose on the grounds.
5. All animals on the grounds will be subject to veterinary inspection if necessary. No animal having a contagious disease shall be allowed to occupy any stall or building on, or be admitted to the grounds, and if any animal has been admitted through an oversight, suffering from any such disease, the animal shall be removed from the grounds immediately.
6. No person will be allowed to act as judge who is in any way interested in the exhibits that person shall judge.
7. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring generators, as power is limited.
