# **AOA Field Rules**

### For All Persons

# Page 1 of 2

- In accordance with AMA rules. All aircraft are to be labeled with the pilots AMA number either inside or outside of the aircraft.
- All aircraft are potentially subject to an air worthiness/ safety inspection by a Board Officer.
- All pilots must have proof of current AMA insurance, digital or hard copy.
- All pilots are to conduct a preflight check of their aircraft & a range check of their radio system as per their radio manufacture instructions if able.

## • Starting & Running of Engines/Motors:

- \*No starting or running of engines or motors under the pavilion at any time unless the Prop/Rotors are removed.
- \*All running Engines/Motors are to be started at the designated starting areas. Always pointed away from
- people & property. (It is your responsibility to make sure no one is in front of your aircraft)
- \*Breaking in an engine is to be done far away from people, property, & not to be left alone.

# Ground Operations:

- \*Only AMA Pilots beyond the first fence nearest the pavilion.
- \*The taxiway is 15ft from the pilot's fence towards the fly over area (East). The taxiway parallels the entire runway.
- \*Taxiway is to be used to give right away for landing, taking off, & dead stick aircrafts.
- \*Never taxi behind people or pilot stations. Start and go out from either the North/South starting areas.
- \*After landing, taxi to the pilot's line and turn off engine. Walk, drag, or carry aircraft back to your staging area.

# Flying Operations:

- \*Before getting airborne. Establish verbally with your fellow pilots a direction for taking off & landing.
- \*All pilots are to call out loud, all intentions of a change for their aircraft. Taxing out, Taking off,
- Touch & Go, Landing, Runway Clear, Dead stick, etc...
- \*Flying area is towards the East, away from the club pavilion.
- \*After landing, Clear the runway to the taxiway. Use the taxiway. Exit taxiway as soon as possible.
- \*Dead stick or engine out aircraft have first priority to the runway.
- \*Wait to recover dead or crashed aircraft after all other aircraft have landed or are kept in air as far as
- possible to the opposite side of the downed aircraft.
- \*No flying behind the pilot's fence. This is towards the club, West.
- \*A pilot in training is to use the clubs designated Flight Instructors, or approved by the Board.

#### Reckless Actions:

- \*No Flying high speed towards the pavilion, High G towards the pavilion, or Buzzing/Flying by people or property.
- \*All in air maneuvers are to be done off the runway, starting at the East edge of the runway and farther
- \*Exceptions to in air maneuvers over the runway are allowed if you are the only one flying or for an
- exhibition.

# **AOA Field Rules**

### Guest Pilots:

- \*Any AMA pilot is allowed to fly as a guest/non member.
- \*They must have proof of current AMA insurance either digitally or hard copy.
- \*A guest is intended for occasional visits. Frequent flying as a guest may result in being asked to join the club.
- \*Guests are only allowed to fly if another Club Member is present.
- \*A guest must follow all of the same rules set by the AMA & AOA Club.

## Non Flying Field Rules

- \*No drugs on the clubs property.
- \*Alcohol is allowed for adults within reason. Consumption of alcohol for pilots means flying must stop
- until you are no longer under the influence.
- \*All persons on club property must conduct themselves in a civil, proper, & polite way.
- \*AOA is a family setting that includes No use of profanity, or confrontational behavior/ attitudes allowed.
- \*Please use the clubs provided cigarette butt collectors.
- \*Please bring home all trash unless there is a trash collection taking place for a special occasion.

\*\*\*During Lawn Maintenance, there is NO flying allowed\*\*\*

This only applies to the runway, Staging area, & Extended Staging area

This does not include the parking lot area.
