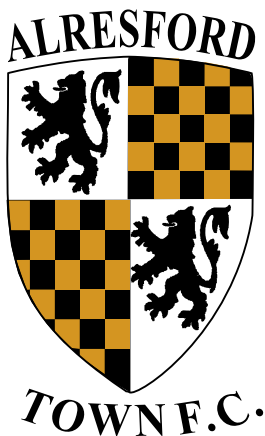

KINTBURY RANGERS HISTORY

Kintbury Rangers were formed in 1890 and had a very successful team between the two World Wars, winning Division One of the Newbury & District League on four occasions in the early 1930's.

The club reformed in 1943 and re-joined the Newbury & District League and quickly became one of the leading clubs in West Berkshire going on to win the Premier Division of the league in 1958-59.

Kintbury won the North Berks League Cup in 1972-73 but it took another 5 seasons to get back to the top division of the league.

In 1983-84 Kintbury joined the Hellenic League Division one and gained promotion to the Premier League in 1987-88. Kintbury remained in the Hellenic League until 1999 when they re-joined the North Berks League. During their time in this league the club won the league three times in a row and achieved the treble of the league, North Berks cup & North Berks Charity Shield in the 2001-02 & 2002-03 seasons.

2004-05 saw Kintbury re-join the Hellenic League they stayed in the league until the end of 2009-10. Season 2010-11 saw Kintbury back in the North Berks league.

In season 2013-14 Kintbury started a period of seven years of great success winning the League title and the North Berks Charity Shield for the 3rd time.

This followed on with another six final wins in the following years with the most recent win being in April 2022 when they won the North Berks War Memorial Cup.

Season 2022-23 saw them once again return to the Wiltshire Senior League where they won promotion to Wessex League in 2025 after the winning the league title.

ALRESFORD TOWN CLUB HISTORY

Football in Alresford has been found back to the late nineteenth century, but the formation year of the present ALRESFORD TOWN FC side is shown as 1989. Starting in the now defunct North Hants League, Town moved immediately into the Hampshire League before withdrawing in 1996. They returned, again from the North Hants League, in 2000 and then came the 2004 move; they've remained members of the Wessex League since and have been a top tier side since 2007.

The original Alresford Town was established in 1898 and were members of the Winchester & District League. The modern club was established in 1989 and joined the North Hants League. After finishing as runners-up in their first season, they moved up to Division Two of the Hampshire League. The club were Division Two runners-up in 1990/91, securing a second successive promotion to Division One. However, after finishing second-from-bottom of Division One in 1994/95, they were relegated back to Division Two. At the end of the following season the club left to re-join the North Hants League.

Alresford were North Hants League champions in 1999/00 and returned to Division Two of the Hampshire League. After finishing second in Division Two in 2001/02 they were promoted to Division One. In 2004 the Hampshire League merged into the Wessex League, with the club becoming members of the new Division Two. The division was renamed Division One in 2006 and Alresford were runners-up in 2006/07, earning promotion to the Premier Division. After five seasons in the lower-mid table, the club were Premier Division runners-up in 2012/13, a season that saw them win the Hampshire Senior Cup (beating AFC Bournemouth in the final), the League Cup and the North Hants Senior Cup. They were Premier Division runners-up again the following season, also retaining the League Cup and the North Hants Senior Cup, as well as winning the Aldershot Senior Cup.

In 2018/19 Alresford won the Southampton Senior Cup, beating AFC Stoneham 3–0 in the final. The 2019/20 season was abandoned due to the coronavirus pandemic with Alresford top of the Premier Division.

In 2021/22 Alresford won the North Hants Senior Cup beating Basingstoke Town 1-0.

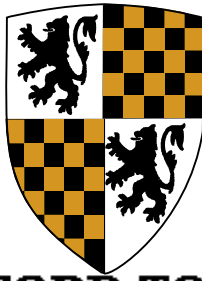

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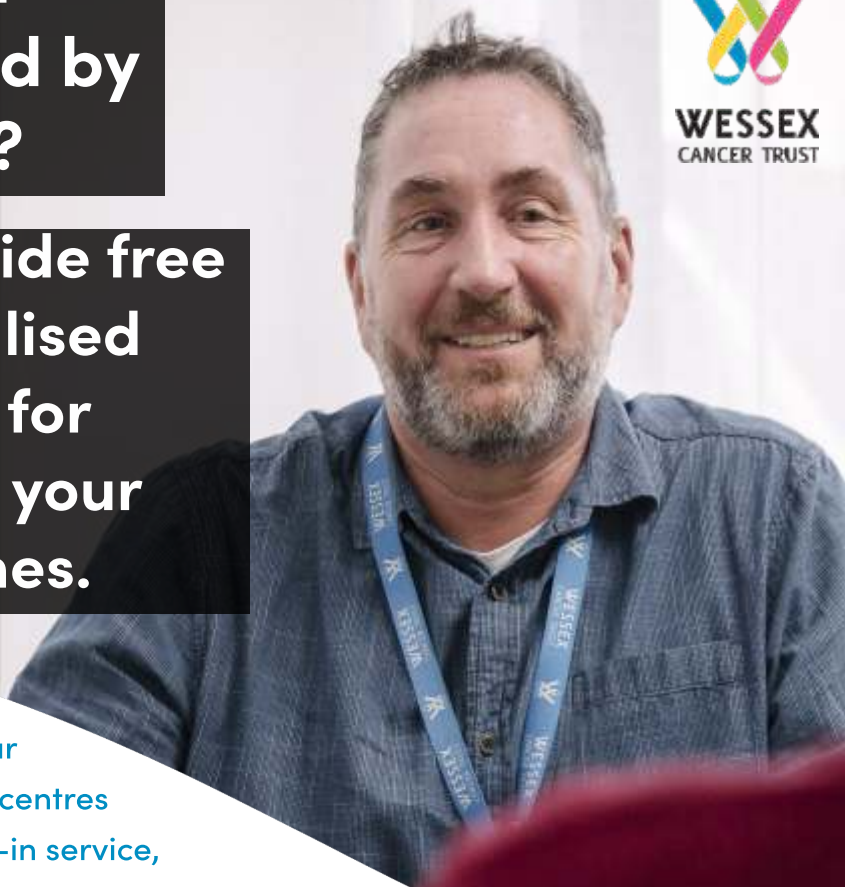
