Footnotes Book Club

Here we are at the last meeting of our fall season and 2018. We will be meeting at the home of Randee Saber. The book will be *The Senator and the Socialite* by Lawrence Otis Graham with discussion led by Virginia McGriggs. Also at this time, we will choose books for **January** through **May 2019**. This past August we will have been meeting for 16 years.

The senator is Blanche Kelso Bruce who was born a slave in 1841 and rises to becoming the first black man elected to a full term in the U. S. Senate. It is much more than that, though, as it chronicles three generations of his family, its rise and its fall. The book is also an excellent history of United States slavery, late nineteenth century politics, and the complexities of being a black and moneyed achiever in the post-Civil War period into the twentieth century.

Lawrence Otis Graham is a nationally known attorney and commentator on race, politics, and class in the United States. Having researched Senate records, historical documents, and personal letters, Graham has produced an impressive and comprehensive history that examines these issues and the Bruce dynasty from 1875-1967. He is the author of thirteen other books. A graduate of Princeton and Harvard Law School, Graham has taught African American studies and American government. His wife, Pamela Thomas-Graham, a novelist and corporate executive in New York City, is leading a campaign to have the USPS create a stamp honoring this first black official in the United States Senate.

Christmas Bird Count for Audubon Society

Bird Feeder Watchers From Your Neighborhood Are Needed

On **Saturday, December 15**, bird feeder watchers from your neighborhood are needed to help with the Spring Creek Christmas Bird Count (CBC).

Each year between **December 14** and **January 5**, the Audubon Society involves people to help the birds by participating in a Christmas Bird Count (CBC). The Audubon Society's goal is to capture a snapshot of bird populations during the early winter, comparing this data with snapshots from scores of previous years to help understand fluctuations in bird populations that show which species are thriving and which are struggling.

One of these CBCs is the Spring Creek CBC on the north side of Houston and is sponsored by volunteers from the Piney Woods Wildlife Society. This CBC is scheduled for the first Saturday of the CBC period – this year it falls on **Saturday, December 15**. It is centered roughly at I45 and Rayford/Sawdust and extends 7.5 miles in all directions. This 15-mile diameter circle makes up the “Spring Creek Christmas Bird Count.” (You can see this and many more CBCs in Texas by visiting www.HoustonAudubon.org/cbc.)

There are two components to counting birds for a CBC. The first consists of teams of bird watchers that go outside and count all the birds that they find in the count circle. The second

consists of people watching their backyard feeders and counting those birds. All this information is turned in to the CBC compiler and reported to the National Audubon Society.

If you live inside the Spring Creek CBC count circle, have bird feeders in your yard, and will be home part of the day on **Saturday, December 15**, please contact the Spring Creek CBC compiler, Claire Moore, and volunteer to help by counting the birds that visit your feeders on that day. Claire will send you further information on how to count and report your sightings. Claire can be reached via email at cdmoore3i@gmail.com.

As mentioned above, volunteers from the Piney Woods Wildlife Society sponsor this CBC. PWWS is a local bird watching and nature club that has meetings on the third Wednesday of each month (except summer months) at 6:30 p.m. The meetings include some snacks plus a presentation by a local person about their bird watching or nature experience. The meetings are held at the Big Stone Lodge at Dennis Johnston Park located at 709 Riley Fuzzel Road in Spring. If you are interested in birds or nature, please feel free to attend the PWWS meetings. You can learn more about PWWS at www.pineywoodswildlifesociety.org/.


