






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#### Flags Across America

#### Youth Unit 1961 – Houston and Spring, TX

"Flags Across America" is a fundraising project for Boy Scout Troop 1961 and the Young Women's Youth Group (YWYG) of the Olde Oaks Ward. The Boy Scouts of America provides a program for young men to develop character, citizenship training, and personal fitness. The program includes hiking, camping, conducting service projects, serving as junior leaders, and working with community leaders. With the purchase of a Texas flag we will place a Texas flag in your yard for Texas Independence Day, March 2. With the purchase of any of the military branch flags we will place that flag in your yard in honor of Armed Forces Day, the third Saturday in May.
