# BOOK CLUB "FOOTNOTES"

On February 22 our group will be discussing a non-fiction book, *Nomadland: Surviving America in the 21st Century*, by Jessica Bruder. The online description states that this 2017 book is "about the phenomenon of older Americans who following the Great Recession from 2007-2009 adopted a transient lifestyle traveling around the United States in search of seasonal work. The author takes us into the lives of several modern-day nomads." The author also describes her journey with one nomad and her other interviews conducted in five states over three years with more than 50 nomads in the first year alone.

Jessica Bruder is an American journalist who writes about subcultures and teaches narrative writing at Columbia Journalism School. She also writes for *WRED*, *New York Magazine*, and *Harper's Magazine*. *Nomadland* was made into a film by the same name in February 2019.
