HOSA provides opportunities for students to develop, practice and refine their technical, leadership, teamwork and soft skills to achieve a seamless transition from education to a health care career.

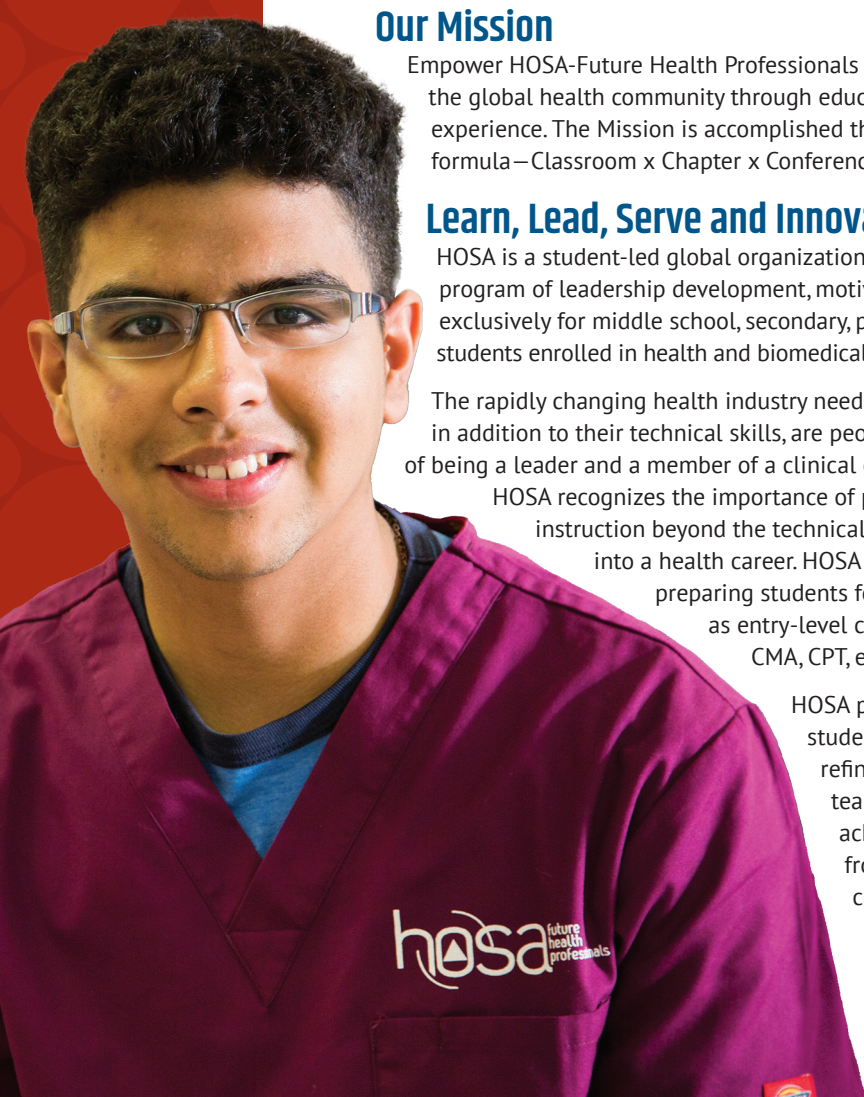

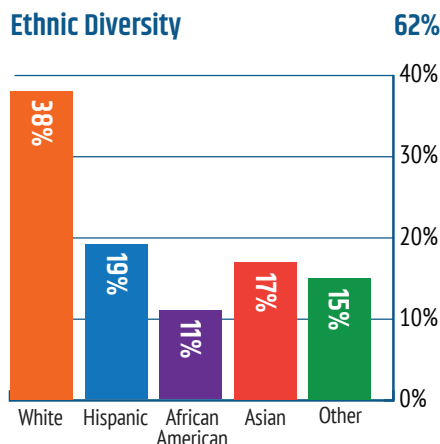
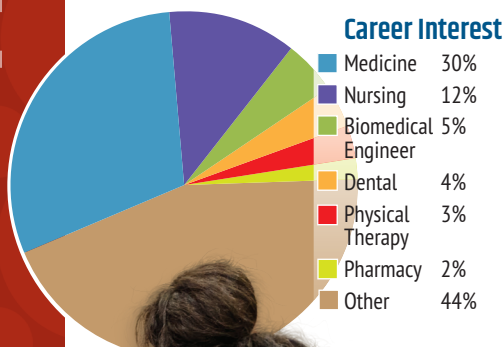
