Good Shepherd Lutheran School is excited to share with you an opportunity for your children to get a quality education with us by accessing FREE TUITION ASSISTANCE through the Oklahoma Parental Choice Program.

#### What Is the Oklahoma Parental Choice Program?

The Oklahoma Parental Choice Program is a free tuition assistance program that allows you to send your children to Good Shepherd and have 100% of their tuition paid in most cases. This means your children can experience the faith-filled, high-quality education offered at Good Shepherd Lutheran School at no cost to you.

#### Who Can Apply?

Great news! The program is open to all Oklahoma families, regardless of income. If you are already receiving SNAP, TANF, or SoonerCare, you are automatically approved for the full tuition amount for each child.

#### How to Apply

Applying is simple and takes just a few steps:

- Visit Good Shepherd Lutheran School and enroll your children.
- 2. After enrolling, you will receive a confirmation number to complete the online application through the Oklahoma Tax Commission. If you are already receiving SNAP, TANF, or SoonerCare, you MUST APPLY for the funding, but you are not required to provide income verification.
- Once approved, Good Shepherd will receive the funds to cover all tuition costs in most cases.




#### 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade
