
The 8 a.m. Holy Eucharist Rite I Service will resume next Sunday.

St. Barnabas' Episcopal Church

110 East Lincoln Street Tullahoma, Tennessee



Episcopal services were inaugurated in Tullahoma in 1867 by the Reverend Harvey O. Judd, Deacon. The small congregation was formally organized as the Mission of the Incarnation. St. Barnabas was associated with the Diocese as a Parish in January 1874 and soon became the center for mission work in the area. The first church building, a frame structure, was consecrated in 1874. In 1897, it was replaced with the present larger sandstone edifice, a Gothic Revival design of architect R.H. Hunt.

Although repairs and updates have been necessary over the years, the church, realizing the history and significance of the building, has been careful to preserve and restore the original features of the building. A new roof in 2012 is a restoration of the original slate roof. The interior was restored in 2014 to its original configuration of plaster walls and dark-wood wainscot. The church is noteworthy for its stained-glass windows. "The Cross in the Crown" over the altar and "The Pelican in Her Piety" in the organ-pipes room probably were installed when the building was first built. The other stain glass windows date back to 1964.
