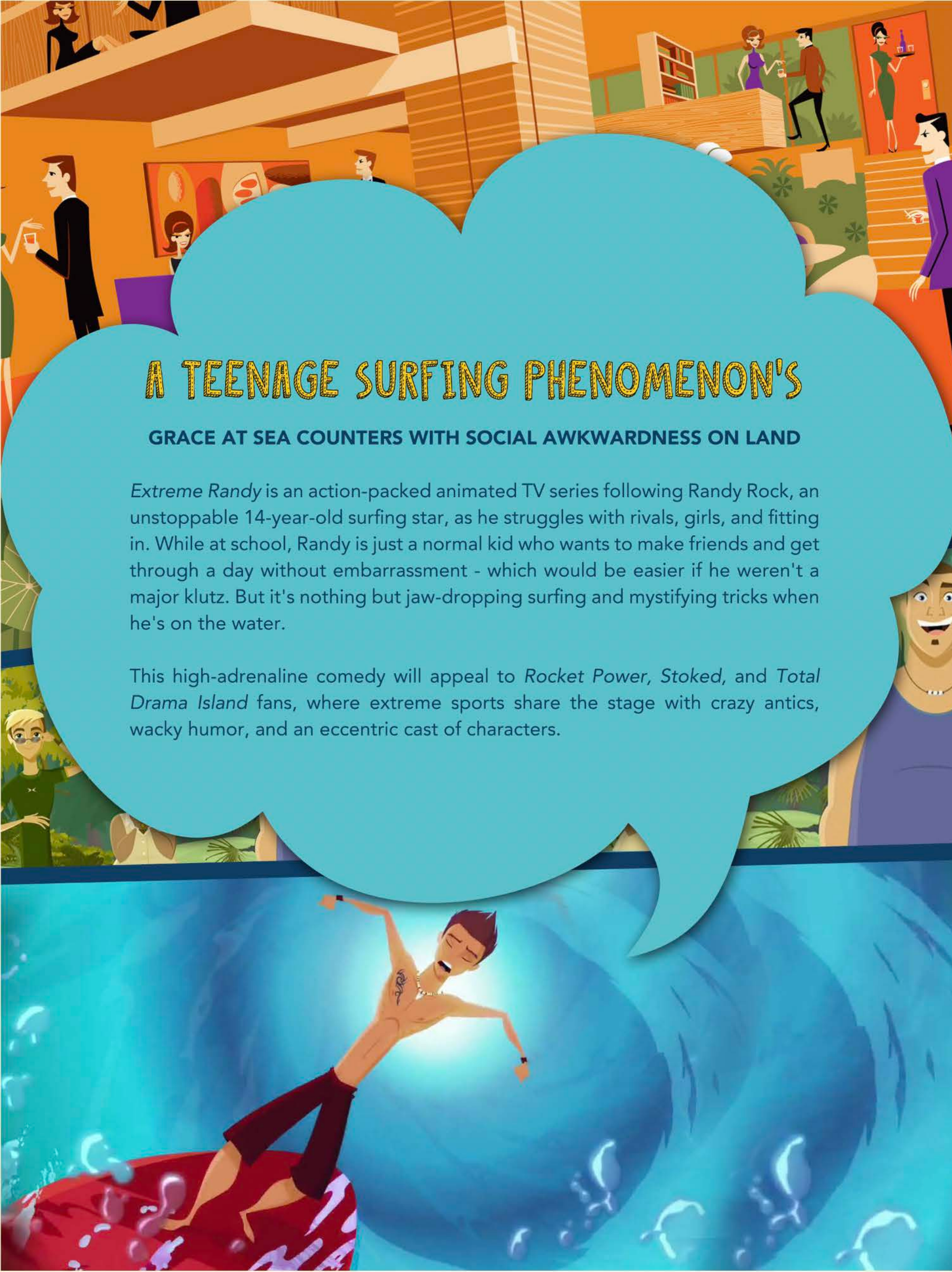

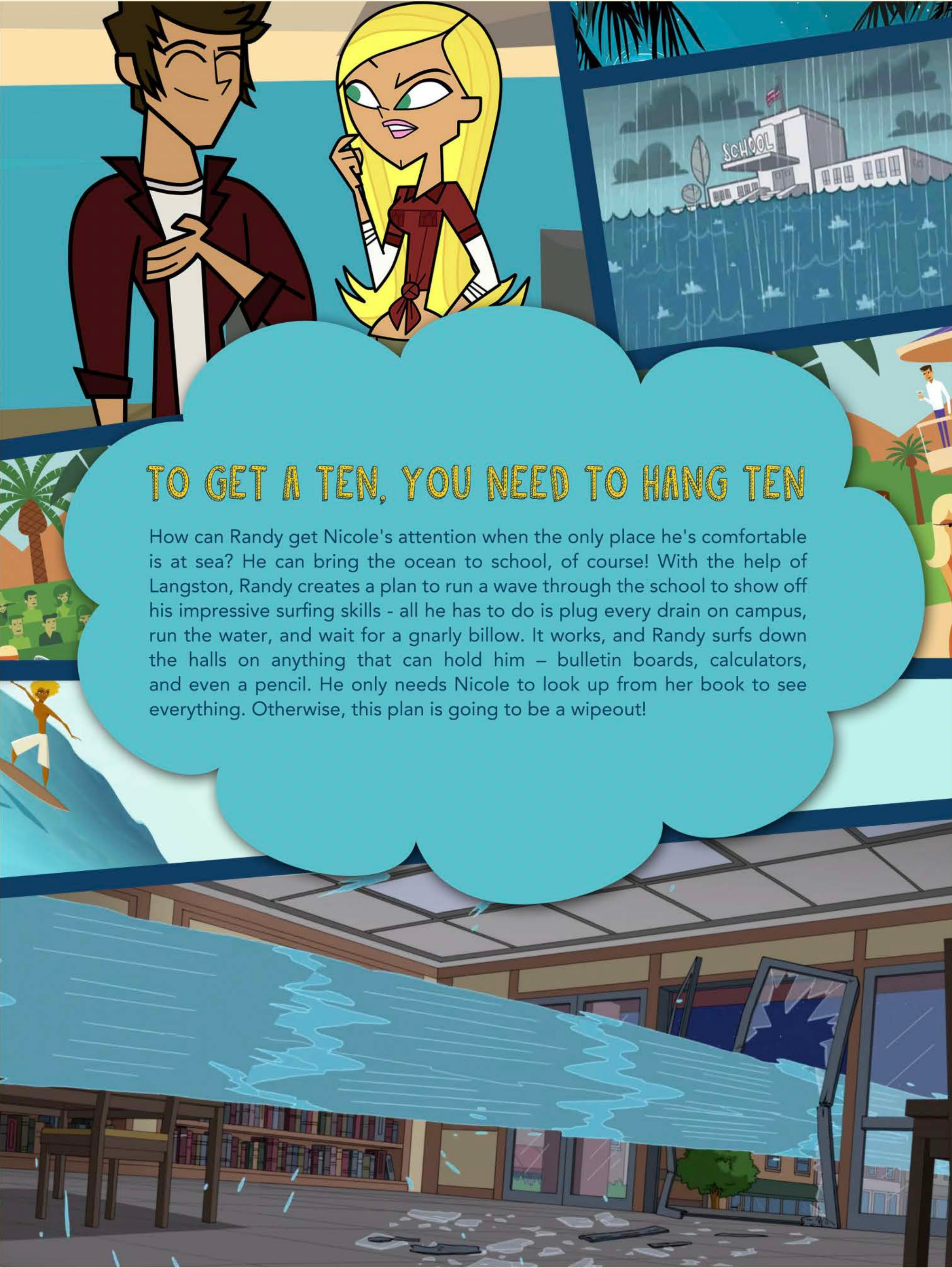




AN EXTREME RIVAL
