Secretary's Report: Kristy Selness read 2-2-2025 Reorganization Meeting minutes. Motion to approve by Al Erickson, seconded by Gary Selness, carried.

Treasurer's Report: Dan Dutka provided an update on Treasurer's report. Income year to date (Feb 28, 2025), current \$6169.00, benevolence \$586. Expenses year to date (Feb 28, 2025), current \$11,542.42, benevolence \$0. Balance of current fund \$25,136.49, benevolence \$1,536.00.
