

Big Canoe Annual Meeting January 26, 2025

President Brian Bigler called the Annual Meeting to order.

Council members present were: Brian Bigler - President, Steve Emery - Vice President, Deb Monson - Secretary, Laurie Emery - Treasurer and Lisa Bullerman - Financial Secretary, Vern Whitaker, Kathryn Thompson, Shelley Bigler, and Bill Bullerman, as well as Pastor Matthew Becker.

Due to time constraints, Danny Dutka (member of Highland) was recognized for all of his work at the parsonage in 2024 in making the parsonage a home for Pastor and Detra. Work at the parsonage is an ongoing process. Danny was presented with a check for \$2,500. Danny was very appreciative of the gift.

The meeting continued with Pastor Becker opening the meeting with prayers asking for God's guidance.

The minutes from the 2024 annual meeting were read. Rita Thomas made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Brian asked for approval of the minutes by asking that all present to raise their right hand. The minutes were approved and placed on file.

Pastor Becker asked that the church conduct an evaluation of his work as our pastor.

Parsonage rent valuation - Pastor Becker needs to provide the IRS with a statement as to the value of rent for living in the parsonage. The rate of \$800 per month was agreed upon by all present as to the rent valuation. (Fair Market Rental Value).

The monthly rent at the parsonage is established at \$800 per month as a Fair Market Value for the 2025 calendar year. The motion was made by Kris Bigler to approve and was seconded by Tammy Nordheim. The motion was approved by all.

Pastor also advised all present members that his sermons or any of his writings do not belong to him, that they are the property of the congregation. Pastor requested that all rights to his sermons, notes, and any and all of his writings be relinquished.

On this date, January 26, 2025, the attendees of the Big Canoe Lutheran Church annual meeting relinquished any and all right to sermons, notes, and any and all writings by Pastor Matthew Becker.

This relinquishment of rights shall cover any and all sermons, notes, writings, etc., of the past, present, and future pertaining to Pastor Matthew Becker serving as pastor of the Big Canoe Lutheran Church, 1381 Big Canoe Road, Decorah, Iowa.

Emma Thompson made a motion to accept and approve the above relinquishment. The motion was seconded by Rita Thomas, and the motion was approved by all.

On behalf of the Auditing Committee, Rita Thomas reported that the auditing was completed and all records were accurate. Other members of the auditing committee are Michelle and Mark Borreson and Earl Arneson.

Laurie Emery gave the Treasurer's Report as to the 2025 Church Budget. Laurie also updated everyone in attendance as to payment of the costs of repairs and remodeling projects at the parsonage.

Money from the Improvement and Elsie Osmundson funds plus two anonymous donations covered the pastor's salary and benevolence expenses.

Lisa Bullerman reported that 10% of the Grindeland account is given to charity. Lisa stated that the 10% should be reduced to 5% so that the monies in the account would last longer. After some discussion, Rita Thomas made the motion to leave the amount given to charity at 10%. The motion was second by Bill Bullerman. The motion was approved by all.

Tammy Nordheim updated everyone as to the Luther League activities and donation to various causes.

The Big Canoe Cemetery Committee has cleaned a lot of the older headstones using a product called D2 Formula. Members of the committee will meet in February.

Elections were had to fill the vacancies by those going off of the council. The three nominees are Seth Ferguson, Eric Stoen, and Loren Amundson along with Vern Whitaker who agreed to stay on the council. The newly elected council members are Vern Whitaker and Seth Ferguson.

The Financial Oversight Committee consists of Lisa Bullerman, Gary Stortz, and Steve Emery. The committee oversees the Grindeland Account and the Elsie Osmundson account which have been combined.

The Aase Haugen Home Committee members have agreed to continue serving. The committee members are Sandy Gavle, Dee Wyatt, and Emma Thompson.

The Nominating Committee members are: Shelley Bigler, Brian Bigler, and Vernoe Whitaker.

The Spring Assembly Conference will be held on February 23 at 2:00 p.m. at the Stavanger Lutheran Church in Ossian. Pastor Becker will be attending along with Rita Thomas who volunteered.

The Synod Assembly will be held on June 7th in Cedar Falls. Those to attend are Pastor Becker along with two adult lay persons and one lay youth. Possible adult lay persons are Rita Thomas and Bill Stoen.

Social Concerns Committee membership will stay the same.

Sunday School Committee - Pastor hopes to start as a Sunday School program this spring with classes every other Sunday at Big Canoe. Parents having children in the Sunday School program would be the teachers. There are possibly twenty children for the program who are very young.

Worship service dates and times are to be established at both Big Canoe and Highland. Both churches need to be mindful of people who are not members but are considering becoming members. The individual church websites are to be kept updated so people know where services are at.

Pastor Becker feels it is good to have both congregations worship together. A possible schedule of having services the first and third Sunday of each month at Big Canoe and the second and fourth Sundays at Highland. If there are five Sundays in a month, services will alternate between Big Canoe and Highland.

Kathryn Thompson said it is nice to have a fuller church just for singing alone. Kathryn also said it is challenging for her as an organist to get between the two churches if there would be services at both churches on Sunday. Furthermore, Kathryn has a lot of weddings to be organist at in 2025. Kathryn will have a designated parking spot with special signage of "Church Organist".

Dave Bigler said that if Kathryn had a conflict with serving as organist, that possibly Colleen could fill in by playing the piano.

As to the serving of Communion: Communion would be served on the first Sunday of the month at Big Canoe and the second Sunday of the month at Highland. If there are five Sundays in a month, communion would be alternated between Big Canoe and Highland.

President Brian Bigler proposed that the new church service and communion schedules begin with the month of March. Special provisions will be made with regard to Easter and Christmas. Rita Thomas made the motion to approve and Dave Bigler seconded. The motion was approved by all.

Pastor Becker will provide the Highland congregation with the above information at Highland's Annual Meeting on Sunday, February 2nd.

President Brian Bigler gave a special notice to Tammy Nordheim who has worked steadily to keep everyone's hopes up during the call process.

Pastor Becker stated that the call video encouraged him and Detra to come here and serve the two congregations.

Regarding weekly offering, the passing of the offering plate is a tried and true way of people giving their offering to the church. However, younger people are more inclined to use a QR code. Consideration should be given to alternative ways for people to give their offerings especially for visitors to the church. Another possibility would be to put a QR code on the church's Facebook page so that people watching our church services by video may also contribute if they wish to do so.

The Ladies Aid is working on serving a meatball dinner on Sunday, August 3rd as a fundraiser for the church. Also, the Ladies Aid made 1,219 quilts that were given away.

Bob Maroushek was presented with a check for \$1,000 as a thank you for all of the extras he has done.

Treasurer Laurie Emery presented the proposed budget for 2025, with a total bottom line of \$154,165.30. President Brian Bigler stated the weekly offering would need to be about \$3,000 per week to handle the budget.

Brian requested a motion for the approval of the 2025 budget. Rita Thomas made a motion to approve the proposed 2025 budget. Kris Bigler seconded the motion and the motion was approved by all.

Shirley Bigler asked about the status of obtaining insurance for the church. Brian informed all that we hope to have quotes in a couple of weeks.

Pastor Becker's long term goals: Pastor would like to have a Spiritual Retreat at church on Saturday, June 21st starting at 10:00 a.m. The retreat would be for the congregation to see where we would like to be in the next year and where we want to be in five years.

Pastoral Acts for 2024 - acts prior to September 2024 were done by various pastors. After October 1, pastoral acts were completed by Pastor Becker.

President Bigler adjourned the annual meeting.

Pastor Becker led the group in the Lord's Prayer.
