

Big Canoe Council Meeting November 10, 2024

President Brian Bigler called the meeting to order. Pastor Becker gave the prayers.

Council members present: President Brian Bigler, Vice President Steve Emery, Secretary Deb Monson, Treasurer Laurie Emery, and council members Bill Bullerman, Vern Whitaker, and Shelley Bigler.

There was no secretary's report to give.

Laurie Emery gave her treasurer's report. The treasurer's report was approved and placed on file.

Laurie advised that it would be beneficial for the church and parsonage to be set up on an even paym system. Even pay fuel costs would be \$535 a month for the church and \$202 for the parsonage. The fuel provider is Farmer's Union Coop of Ossian.

Shelley made the motion to establish an even pay system with Farmer's Union Coop. Bill seconded the motion, motion passed.

A letter has been received from Church Mutual that they will be dropping the church's insurance coverage on 12/31/24 due to recent claims by the church.

Pastor Becker said he learned at the synod meeting that churches are to contact the synod office as to other possibilities that may be available.

The annual policy cost is \$12,000.00. It was discussed to put the current insurance rate the church is paying into a short term savings account until an insurance provider can be found.

Bids would be taken and put to a congregational vote. Pastor will provide a number to the synod office for Brian to explore the options.

The rental of the church land will be discussed at the next joint meeting. A bid of \$265 per acre for 18 acres has been received and will be reviewed before March 1, 2025.

The Upper Iowa River Conference has requested a donation.

The church's annual Benevolence budget of \$8,100 was discussed. Could the Thanksgiving offering be used for the church's Benevolence monies so we can meet our budget.

It should be posted in the monthly newsletter the names of the ushers who will be serving to pass the offering plate.

Pastor Becker updated the council as to the home visits he made to the housebound congregants. Pastor will visit the housebound once a month.

Motion to adjourn by Steve, seconded by Vernoe, meeting was adjourned.

Meeting closed with Pastor Becker giving prayers.


