Highland Lutheran Church Organizational Council Meeting - February 28, 2021

Call to Order

The organizational council meeting of Highland Lutheran Church was called to order by outgoing President Gary Halverson at approximately 12:15 p.m. Sunday February 28, 2021.

In attendance were: Pastor Waldemar Gies, President Gary Halverson, Vice President Al Erickson, Treasurer Anna Jetson, Secretary Danny Dutka, Joyce Bjerke, Steve Langland, Virginia Karlsbroten, Mark Sollien.

Opening Devotion - Pastor Waldemar Gies gave an opening prayer.

Secretary Report - Steve Langland moved to dispense with reading of the minutes of the last meeting. Al Erickson seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report - Treasurer Anna Jetson gave a brief report. Balances as of 2/28/2021 were: Current \$3,122.00, Benevolence \$1,017.00, 125th Anniversary \$355.00, Improvement \$49,039.22, Scholarship \$5,854.62. Report is filed for audit.

Election of Officers - Gary Halverson and Anna Jetsons term on the council are expiring at this meeting. New council persons elected at the Annual Meeting are Virginia Karlsbroten and Mark Sollien.

President - President Halverson opened the floor for nominations for President. Steve Langland nominated Al Erickson. Al stated he would prefer not to be President at this time, therefore there was no second to the nomination. Danny Dutka nominated Joyce Bjerke, nomination was seconded by Steve Langland. After brief discussion Danny moved that nomination cease, motion seconded by Virginia. Motion carried. Joyce Bjerke was elected President. Gary Halverson turned over the meeting to the newly elected President. President Bjerke thanked Gary for his service.

Vice-President - President Bjerke asked for nominations for Vice-President. Virginia Karlsbroten nominated Al Erickson, Steve Langland seconded the nomination. Steve moved that nominations cease, Danny Dutka seconded the motion. Motion carried. Al Erickson was elected Vice-President.

Secretary - President Bjerke asked for nominations for Secretary. Steve Langland nominated Danny Dutka, Al Erickson seconded the nomination. Virginia Karlsbroten moved nominations cease, Al Erickson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Danny Dutka was elected Secretary.

Appointments - Danny Dutka moved to appoint Anna Jetson as Treasurer. Steve Langland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Danny Dutka moved to appoint Virginia Karlsbroten as Financial Secretary. Al Erickson seconded the motion. Motion carried

Pastoral Call Process - Former President Halverson had received an email regarding setting a date to have a Zoom electronic audio / video meeting with Rev. Stephen Brackett assistant to the Bishop of the NE Iowa Synod. The council decided that Wednesday March 24 would be our first choice and Tuesday March 30 would be alternate.

The council discussed interim pastoral ministry options.

Lenten Service - The council decided that volunteers from Highland would lead, or assist Pastor Gies, at the March 17th Lenten service to be held at Big Canoe.

Council Meeting Dates - Council discussed potential meeting dates and times for the remainder of the year. Meetings will be Sunday at 9:30 a.m. if there is an 11 a.m. service or follow a 9 a.m. service. Dates selected are: March 14, April 11, May 9, June 13, July 11, August 8, September 12, October 10, November 14, December 12. Meetings may be cancelled or postponed as deemed necessary.

Directory - The council reviewed the names of people who are delegates, members of various committees and other positions within the church. The secretary will work on updating this listing for 2021.

Other - Virginia Karlsbroten mentioned that some of the Cemetery Committee records at being kept in the safe at her home due to Lyle Bjerke recovering from recent surgeries. Virginia's husband Dennis is a member of the Cemetery Committee.

The council discussed various other topics but took no official action.

Adjournment - Mark Sollien moved to adjourn the meeting, Steve Langland seconded. Motion carried. The Lord's Prayer was recited.
