#### March 7, 2023, Big Canoe Council Meeting

The Big Canoe church council met on March 7, 2023 at 6:30 pm for its regular monthly meeting. Members present included: Pat O'Regan, Shelly Bigler, Steve Emery, Kathryn Thompson, Brian Bigler, Rita Thomas and Treasurer Laurie Emery.

Pat called the meeting to order with prayer. The minutes for the January meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was accepted and placed on file. Laurie reported a balance on hand of \$1,144.44 (without last Sunday's offering) and a balance of \$5,495.38 in the parsonage fund.

All bills have been paid and the insurance has been settled for the roofing project at the church, parsonage and janitor's house. After insurance monies were applied to the roofing bill, \$5,361 was paid from the parsonage fund. \$7,500 was used from the improvement fund to pay for the gutters that were put on. Good job, well done. Our insurance carrier, Church Mutual, conducted an inspection of the church mid-February. We passed without any complaints.

Lawn repairs around the church will be done this spring when weather permits. Steve Emery will be in charge on the operation. Pat will work up the ground that has been pushed up. Bob Thomas will supply the Bobcat for the dirt placement and leveling. Joel Anderson has dirt that we can use as fill for the price of a tax write off note. Gary Stortz has volunteered to furnish the grass seed for the project. Steve motioned, Rita seconded, that we accept his offer with our thanks. Motion passed. Bob T. and Pat will furnish the straw that will be needed. All are encouraged to come and help when the project is in progress. It was also decided that during the work everyone needs to look at the outside of the church and check for places we may need to do tuckpointing as we will be accepting bids this summer to have this work done.

We have received five bids for mowing the cemetery. The cemetery committee will make the final determination on the final bid acceptance early in March. Options were discussed on how the payments for the contract should be split between the church and the cemetery. No final decision has been reached pending input from the cemetery committee.

Bob M. has been doing routine checks on the furnace, opening the church and taking care of the sidewalks. After his checkup this spring the council will meet with him and discuss arrangements for summer mowing and other duties he is able to perform. May he live long and prosper.

At the annual meeting it was voted on that those who had helped out at the church during this past year should submit bills to the council. That included cleaning, mowing, snow removal etc. The council would also like to extend a most sincere and heartfelt THANK YOU to all who pitched in.

The new budget for 2023 was accepted by unanimous consent.

Election of officers was held. Our new President will be Brian Bigler, Vice President Pat O'Regan and Secretary Rita Thomas. Brian took over Presidential duties from Pat.

The council will be changing the date and time when we meet. We will meet the first Sunday of each month after regular church services.

The council will provide bars and coffee after church on Sunday, March 12.

A motion to adjourn was made by Rita, seconded by Pat, and accepted. We closed with the Lord's Prayer. Respectfully submitted, Rita Thomas, Secretary
