JULY 9, 2023

Brian Bigler, Council President Opened meeting at 11:10.

Pastor Gies opened with a devotion focused on the congregation's mission of serving and growing in Christ.

Laurie Emery provided a 2nd QTR Financial Report along with Big Canoe Parsonage Account information.

Unfinished Business

A discussion ensued regarding pending financial obligations. A letter will be mailed out to Big Canoe Members, regarding how the Congregation will go forward to meet these obligations. Pat O'Regan made the motion to send out such a letter and Shelley Bigler 2nd, motion passed unanimously.

Have you tried FAITH5?













Faith5 was developed by Dr. Rich Melheim, a Lutheran Pastor, and founder of Faith Inkubators, to help nurture children's faith, create a caring atmosphere, and instill a sense of security. It is a 5-step, daily practice that consists of: 1) Sharing "Highs & Lows" of the day; 2) reading a Bible verse together; 3) discussing or talking about

how the Bible verse might relate to the high & low; 4) praying together; and 5) blessing each other. It is a great way to set aside 10 or 15 minutes daily to "connect" with your child and stay in touch with what is going on in their world. However, FAITH5 is not limited to just nuclear families, anyone can practice FAITH5 too.
