Big Canoe Council Meeting Thursday, April 8, 2021

Meeting was called to order

Laurie gave the treasurer's report. Balance is \$5,209.82 with no loan balances owed.

Minutes were approved as published in the April Newsletter.

Old Business: The rental sheet was reviewed and a minor changes noted: Whomever is the acting Pastor at the time of the event will need to review and approve the requested(If any) church services.

Council is looking for interested parties in the Pastor search. We already have Tammy, Colleen, and Ashley and requesting a HS Luther League member to serve as well. Any interested parties should contact a Council Member.

The Council is working on an Interim Offer to Pastor Gies with the Synod. Pastor is interested to help support our communities. More to come as we visit with the Synod.

The \$500 donation from Regan Jewell, I believe, is going to be used for trees. Pat Is looking further into that.

A new set of Liturgical Stoles to be chosen by the Altar Committee was approved for purchase up to \$1500. This amount should be more than sufficient to cover the purchase and likely they will not need this much.

A brief update on the status of the Parsonage was given. Bob has been checking regularly and we have an agreement with a pest control person. This issue is in continuing discussion.

Council was advised of the Benefit for Phyllis being chaired by Luther League and Social Concerns committee.

Meeting closed with the Our Father and all were dismissed.

Highland Lutheran Church Council Meeting - April, 11, 2021

Call to Order

The April 11, 2021 meeting of the Highland Lutheran Church council was called to order by President Joyce Bjerke at approximately 9:30 a.m. Others in attendance were Vice President Al Erickson, Secretary Danny Dutka, Treasurer Ann Jetson, Steve Langland, Virginia Karlsbroten and Karen Erickson WELCA President.

Opening Prayer

President Bjerke gave an opening prayer.

Secretary Report

Danny Dutka read the minutes of the last council meeting held on February 28, 2021. There being no corrections or additions it was moved by Steve Langland to approve the minutes. Virginia Karlsbroten seconded the motion. Motion carried by voice vote.

Treasurer Report

Anna Jetson presented the Treasurer Report. The end of the first quarter balances were: Current \$4076.76, Benevolence \$481.00, 125th Anniversary \$355.10, Improvement \$\$45046.87, Scholarship \$5855.12. We have receipt of \$50 direct deposit from Thrivent which happens yearly, we would like to acknowledge our benefactor, however due to it being a direct deposit there is no accompanying donor information. Moved by Steve Langland, seconded by Al Erickson to file report for audit. Motion carried by voice vote.

Pastoral Vacancy

Rev. Stephen Brackett of the NE Iowa Synod will be at Big Canoe on Thursday April 15 at 6 p.m. to inform us of what we need to do to start the call process.

Shared Ministry

We have received a letter from St. Johns (Locust) and Hauge call committee wondering of our interest in discussing the possible formation of geographic parishes. Consensus at our Annual Meeting was that we should continue discussions with area churches. Council affirmed this and will send a reply.

Newer Business

The council discussed making more formal arrangements with Rev. Gies. He has indicated he would be willing to continue serving our congregations. Currently he is acting as a Supply Pastor providing us with worship services and being paid according to Synod guidelines. With a more formal agreement he could be considered an Interim. A suggestion that this be a quarter time position made the Council wrestle with what a quarter time in a Pastor's world would be. We discussed what we would like him to do for us. That list includes: Sunday and other services including funerals, assist with Youth Education (Sunday School & Confirmation), Visitation of shut in's, provide Pastoral message for newsletter, conduct some Adult education, possibly have "office hours" one day per week. Council discussed a potential salary figure, he would also receive a Social Security offset on that salary and mileage reimbursement at the I.R.S. rate. The agreement would be reviewed at a joint council meeting at the end of the year. Danny Dutka moved to take these thoughts to Big Canoe for further discussion. Steve Langland seconded the motion. Motion passed by voice vote.

Newer Business (continued)

The Secretary provided those in attendance a proposed 2021 Directory of council members, committee members, and delegates. After a correction is made the Directory will be published in the newsletter. The Janitorial (usher) schedule for worship services will also be placed in the newsletter.

The Secretary mentioned that the Calling Tree also needs updating. The Secretary will make the changes needed and present to the Council. The Callling Tree is used by the Council when we need to contact people when we cancel services due to inclement weather.

A suggestion was made that the Council should review the Membership Roster. Some corrections should be made as people have passed away, have transferred out, are known to attend other churches, or just haven't been active in attendance or support. No formal action was taken.

There is concern over the water quality at the church. We have been providing chilled bottled water for Pastor vs. from the tap. A sample of water will be taken to the County for testing.

President Bjerke noted that there is a uneven joint on the sidewalk from the north tree line that should be marked with bright paint until this can be addressed otherwise.

Adjournment

Due to it being almost 11 a.m. it was moved and seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.
