Big Canoe Lutheran Church Council Meeting, October 8, 2023

The Big Canoe church council met for its rescheduled monthly meeting on October 8, following services and lunch at the Highland Church. Members present were: Shelly Bigler, Pat O'Regan, Pastor Gies, Treasurer Laurie Emery, Vern Whitaker, Brian Bigler and Rita Thomas.

Brian called the meeting to order and Pastor Gies led us in a short devotion and prayer.

Secretary's report was approved as read and placed on file.

Treasurer reported a balance of \$1,855.55. Her report was accepted and placed on file.

OLD BUSINESS

- **Confirmation report** Shelly reported that most of the plans as of right now are on hold as the new Pastor at Glenwood is just getting settled in and would like a month or so to get better acquainted with the congregations before forming any concrete plans.
- **CD report** Pat stated that CDs at the moment are paying around 5.5%. We will be closing our old CD's and reinvesting at the higher rate.
- Paul Hexom has requested that his membership be transferred back to Big Canoe. Request will be granted.
- The Big Canoe organ needs to be repaired and the pianos need tuning. Kathryn will handle the arrangements.
- The Big Canoe WELCA will be holding a chicken dinner drive through next June.
- We still need to get another bid for our tuck-point project.

NEW BUSINESS

Since Christmas Eve is on a Sunday, it was decided to have only the Christmas Eve service at 4:30 p.m. on that day and dispense with the regular Sunday morning service at Big Canoe. Christmas day service will be at 10:00 a.m. on December 25.

Ash Wednesday is early this year on February 14, 2024.

The Lenten services will be: supper 6:00 p.m., choir practice at 6:30 p.m., and church service at 7:00 p.m.

• Where they will be held has not yet been determined.

Maunday Thursday services will be 6:30 p.m. at Highland. Good Friday service at 6:30 p.m. at Big Canoe. Easter services will be March 31, 2024: Big Canoe at 8:00 a.m. with breakfast and pie auction to follow, and Highland service at 10:00am.

The money from the pie auction proceeds was discussed. No decision was reached on how it should be divided. There is a female seminary student from Waukon who may be available as interim pastor or at least be able to share duties with Pastor Gies. Pastor will speak with her and see if she is amenable to the idea and if she would be suitable. He will report to the council.

Winter cancellation of services was discussed. It was decided that Pastor would speak to both council Presidents and they would make a joint decision. It could be such that Pastor could not be here and the council Presidents would decide if we wanted to hold a service on our own.

Highland Lutheran Church Council Meeting, October 15, 2023

Call to Order

The October 15, 2023 meeting of the Highland Lutheran Church Council was called to order by President Steve Langland at 11:04 a.m. at the Highland Lutheran Church. Council members in attendance: President Steve Langland, Vice President Mark Sollien, Secretary Darlene Sollien, Anna Jetson council member and Treasurer, and council members Virginia Karlsbroten and Al Erickson. Pastor led council in short devotion and prayer. **Secretary's Report**

A motion was made by Anna Jetson and seconded by Mark Sollien to suspend the reading of the minutes and to approve. Motion carried.

Financial Report

Anna Jetson provided printed materials for the monthly/quarterly reports. Balances as of October 5, 2023 were:

Anna noted that we have only met 48% of the benevolence budget with only one quarter left. She was instructed to make an announcement at church, put something in both the newsletter and the bulletin. There were no other questions or concerns.

A motion was made by Mark Sollien and seconded by Al Erickson to approve the 3rd quarter 2023 financial report. Motion carried by unanimous vote. The October 2023 financial report is subject to audit.

Old Business

- Congregational meeting next Sunday: Steve wanted to be sure that we were prepared for the congregational meeting next Sunday regarding the altar rail and chairs. Steve did some checking on redoing the chairs and estimated cost is \$300 to \$500 each.
- 2. Retaining Wall: Steve informed the group that the removal of the retaining wall should start in a couple of weeks. Virginia suggested that we have a professional redo the landscaping for us. All were in agreement with that suggestion. Briefly discussed the request for funds from the Depot and anyone going to ask for funds should be prepared to answer questions about our project. Current request is for replacing the inside doors in the basement. Dan Dutka has a price of \$840.00 per door/frame (that does not include installation.) These doors need to be custom made and the price reflects that.

New Business


- 1. Christmas Services: Pastor informed us of the proposal that was accepted by Big Canoe.
 - Regular worship services in December will be at Highland.
 - December 17th, services will be at Big Canoe for the children's Christmas program.
 - Sunday December 24th no regular church service but there will be a 4:30 PM Christmas Eve candle light service with Holy Communion at Highland.
 - Christmas Day, 10:00 AM service at Big Canoe with Holy Communion.
- 2. Lenten Services 2024: Pastor informed us of the proposal that was accepted by Big Canoe.
 - Ash Wednesday, February 14th, Big Canoe with Holy Communion.
 - Easter, March 31, Separate services: 8:00 AM service at Big Canoe, with 10:00 AM service at Highland
 - March 28, Maundy Thursday service at 6:30 with Holy Communion at Highland
 - March 29, Good Friday services at Big Canoe with no communion.
 Holden Evening Prayer will be used for the round robin services and there is a preliminary plan as to where they will be held. A meal will be served at 5:45 or 6:00 PM prior to services.
 Counsel accepted the proposal as presented and it's OK to publicize.
- 3. Winter Services: Discussion held with regard to any proposals that may come up at the joint meeting with regard to where services are held Big Canoe, Highland, sanctuary or basement. Counsel is willing to work out whatever is needed.
- 4. New Vacuum: We will talk to Joyce and Lyle about the vacuum and see if they would like something different.
- 5. **Other:** Mark indicated that the AED equipment needs to be checked. Dan Dutka has taken care of this for us so we have no issues. We do need training. We will train for use not certification. Training will be set on December 10th after church. Lisa Bullerman is the contact for this.

Anna indicated that she noticed a couple of the stained-glass panels above the entrance door are broken. No real concerns at this time as there is a storm on the outside. Perhaps Depot money could be used to repair. Various appreciation gifts were discussed.

We agreed to donate \$500 to the Fall Appeal for the Synod. We can take the monies from the scholarship fund. Discussed having clean up days where everyone helps to clean the church or sign up for certain duties. Anna asked that we think about areas of growth and training; specifically think about the usage of our building. Motion by Mark Sollien and second by Virginia Karlsbroten to adjourn. Motion carried. We closed with the Lord's Prayer. The meeting ended at 12:05 PM.
