Rev. Stephen Brackett, assistant to the bishop, has done some filming of Big Canoe and Highland. He has so graciously volunteered to put a short video together for perspective pastors to view. Keep him in your prayers as he helps us in this process.

Big Canoe Council Meeting, Sunday, September 3, 2023

All council members were present except Rita Thomas. Pastor Gies opened with prayer.

Laurie Emery Provided an updated financial report noting we are behind on Benevolence and still owe the Cemetery \$3,238.89 for last year's mowing. The Parsonage Fund has a balance of \$7549.58

Continued Business:

Shelley Bigler is coordinating with Glenwood, Burr Oak and Big Canoe to combine for confirmation Classes.

Bill Stoen is submitting a request to The Depot for a \$5,000 grant to work on the Tuck Point Project. Bill will present the proposal on September 12th.

New Business:

The Assistant Bishop assisted the Big Canoe Call Video. He was very pleased with the progress and end product.

Helen Arneson bequested the Big Canoe church a very nice amount of \$80,000. These funds are to be spent as the needs of the church arise.

The Council decided to place \$50,000 in a certificate of deposit for pending new pastoral expenses. \$20,000 would go to a money market account for upcoming expenses (cemetery and other projects) and the balance for current expenses. The Council selected Pat O'Regan to look into best case scenarios for earnings on these accounts. Vern Whitaker made the motion, Shelley Bigler seconded, and the motion passed. Pat will pursue these options this month.

A concern about the maintenance of the pipe organ included asking Katherine to look into an agreement with a vendor.

There was discussion of a fall or early winter fund raising event, such as a chicken drive through dinner. The congregation is welcome to make suggestions.

A youth and family service on September 17th is greatly anticipated.

Next council meeting is Sunday, October 1st after services at Highland.

Pat O'Regan motioned to adjourn. Katherine seconded; the motion passed.

Pastor Gies ended with closing prayer.
