Call to Order

Secretary Report

Secretary Dutka didn't have a hard copy of the minutes from the April 10, 2022 meeting so he was unable to provide an accurate reading. Darlene Sollien was able to provide a synopsis from her notes.

Treasurer Report

Anna Jetson provided printed and verbal information on the finances of the church. Balances as of August 13, 2022 were: Current \$11,927.34, Benevolence \$289.00, Anniversary Fund \$365.10, Improvement Fund \$70,458.28, Scholarship Fund \$5863.72. Second quarter report was also provided. Treasurer Jetson noted that 59% of the Benevolence budget had been paid out which is similar to last year. The printed Treasurer reports will be filed for audit. Copies of these printed reports will be available to the congregation at the church.

Other

Jake from Jake's Roofing was present to speak on his proposal for repairing the bell tower. The proposal was based upon visual images obtained by drone. He was able to go into the bell tower to inspect. He verified that the steel roofing on the lower section was improperly installed as suspected. He also pointed out that the upper shingled section was leaking as there was wet boards above the bell. Council took the proposal under advisement and would like to have proposal(s) from other qualified contractors before bringing it to the congregation for action.

Membership Review

Darlene Sollien distributed a draft letter that she and Virginia Karlsbroten have composed. This letter is to be sent to those persons listed as having membership at Highland but haven't participated actively. Inactive members may be removed from the Membership Roll per our constitution. Council members will review the letter and further discuss how to proceed.

Adjournment

A motion to adjourn was made by Karen Erickson and seconded by Steve Langland. Motion carried by voice vote.
