



Summer 2021 Health and Safety Guidelines

The safety of our young artists, families, and staff is our top priority. In order to keep everyone safe during the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, we've implemented some new safety guidelines and protocols this summer. We know that this summer may look a little different than past years but rest assured, we'll still be having lots of fun!

- **MASKS:** All students, family, and staff are required to wear a mask at all times in the ArtReach Orlando Community Classroom space. Masks must be worn over the nose and mouth at all times. Extra masks will be provided for anyone who needs one.
- **HEALTH MONITORING / SCREENING:** Upon arrival, all students must complete a short, daily check-in using the CDC website. More information upon registration.
- **DROP-OFF / PICK UP:** Student drop-off and pick-up will be conducted outside the community classroom. Parents and/or guardians must remain in their vehicles.
- **CAPACITY:** Camp capacity has been reduced. Each week of camp will be limited to 15 students and up to 4 staff members (total number below 50% of room capacity). Students will select their seating for the week on the first day, and each student will receive a set of art materials to use.
- **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** Art tables will be spaced 6 feet apart. Students are to practice physical distancing to the greatest extent possible.
- **HYGIENE:** ArtReach Orlando will encourage good hygiene practices such as regular hand washing and use of hand sanitizer.
- **LUNCH AND SNACK:** No food or beverage may be consumed indoors during camp except for a personally labeled water bottle. Snack breaks and lunch will be held outdoors this year.
- **DAILY CLEANING:** ArtReach staff will clean and disinfect all high-touch surfaces after each day of camp including tables, chairs, bathrooms, and shared art supplies.
- **SYMPTOMS / EXPOSURE:** We ask that you please keep your child at home if they are experiencing any symptoms or are generally feeling unwell. If a student or immediate family member of a student has tested positive for Covid-19 during the camp week, the student will not be allowed to return to camp without a negative Covid-19 test. Unfortunately, registration payments will not be refunded. Should a student feel ill during the camp day, they will be provided a space away from other students until they can be picked up.

All students and their families must comply with ArtReach Orlando's health and safety guidelines. Individuals who do not follow our health and safety guidelines will not be permitted to attend camp.
