Matches with A are part of an away match points series.

Matches with C are part of a points series on canals.

Matches with L are part of a points series on lakes.

Points awarded in all championship matches also count towards the Over 50's trophy for those eligible.

BOOK IN. If you intend to fish a match you must 'Book In' in advance. Some matches have a limited number of spaces but it also helps the match stewards with pegging. To 'Book In' you must let Alan Beaven know in advance. If a limit match is oversubscribed preference will be given to those who have attended the work parties. Oversubscribed limit matches will not count for trophies.

MATCH STEWARDS. Should it occur that the regular match stewards are not available and there are no volunteers at the meeting prior to the match it may be necessary for those fishing the match to steward it themselves. It will be arranged for the scales to be available at the draw location.

CHANGE OF VENUE. If a venue is flooded, frozen or becomes unsuitable for some other reason an alternate venue may be used. This may also occur if we receive information which leads us to believe that a venue is fishing particularly badly. Changes will be shown on the club web site, Facebook page and given at the meeting prior to the match. If you are unsure, please contact one of the people listed at the bottom of this sheet.

POOLS. Pools are optional on all home matches. The match fee of £1 is compulsory on **ALL** club matches and helps to pay for trophy engraving. Pools on away matches are subject to the host club's rules.

MATCHES AT COMMERCIAL FISHERIES. There will be a day ticket to pay for at these matches. At the discretion of the committee these may be reduced.

WORKING PARTY MATCHES. To qualify for this trophy, you must attend at least two working parties. Non-qualifiers for the trophy can fish this match and take part in the pools but will not be eligible to win the trophy. If there is a limit on the number of participants, then those who have completed the working parties will take precedence. The day ticket fee for these matches will be reduced for qualifiers.

COMMITTEE MATCH. To qualify for this trophy, you must be a member of the committee. Non-committee members can fish this match and take part in the pools but will not be eligible to win the trophy. If there is a limit on the number of participants, then qualifiers will take precedence. The day ticket fee for these matches will be reduced for qualifiers.

SPECIMEN CLAIMS. Trophies are awarded for match caught specimens. These will be awarded to the largest fish of the following species above the minimum qualifying weight. Barbel 4 lb, Bream 4 lb, Carp 6 lb, Chub 3 lb, Dace 5 oz, Perch 1 lb, Pike 5 lb, Roach 12 oz, Tench 3 lb.

BAIT BANS & SPECIFIC VENUE RULES. Bloodworm & Joker are banned on the matches on the Basingstoke Canal and Wey Navigation Canal. We will endeavour to inform the members of any particular bans or special rules on venues we are visiting but the final responsibility for adherence to these rules lies with the individual member.

VENUE CLOSURES. The following applies to **ALL** members without exception.

The Team Invitation match will use all pegs on Potts Field / Home Park. For this reason, they are not available for pleasure fishing until the match has finished.

Members wishing to pleasure fish on a match date or when there is a visiting club may do so providing they do not arrive until after the start of the match and do not choose a swim within two pegs of anyone taking part in the match.

SELECTION FOR OWAC TEAM INVITATION & FIELD CUP TEAM MATCHES.

Any member wishing to be considered for selection in the team for the Invitation match or Field Cup match should enter their name and contact details on the relevant list on the notice board in the clubhouse (or get someone to do it for you!). Once the teams are selected the successful members will be notified by the team captain.
