

- 5-Stand shoot days have been moved to Saturdays to test attendance
- North Valley High 5-Stand Roof Welding Project:
 - No county permit required is under 120 sqft.
 - Eric the Welding teacher will organize welding students from local high school to complete the pproject and there will be no cost to JCSA/RVSC
 - JCAS approved RVSC to move forward
 - Board agreed to a 6-station design to include 5 individual shooting stands and 1 scorekeeper booth (with a desk)



Range Master (Jim)

- o Battery/Solar Project:
 - 4 batteries and about 8 solar panels (with integrated charge controllers) are ready to deploy as lead acids die
- o Golf Carts:
 - Tires have been replaced and batteries changed
 - Land Pride having some starting issues. In progress
- Next Workday:
 - 12/7 was selected as the "Fall Fling" Workday
 - The board would like to ask Paul to lead the effort again!
 - Chris stated he and Jim will mark some trees to be cut specifically to improve solar charging and bird path
 - Station 1: Add to December workday
 - Station 11: Add to December workday

 - cut/pile/burn at least 5 dead pines on the course, several station
 - cut/modify most green benches on range, less likely to tip with someone sitting on one end
 - cut/remove/burn a few fallen trees
 - finish Sta 11 shooting platform
 - clean/sort/save/scrap stuff in "buggy shed"
 - paint buggy shed?
 - do something with Sta 1 elevated platform?
 - do something with unused platform between Sta 7 & Sta 8?
 - cut/burn low dead moss covered pine branches along range road, reduce fire hazard
 - relocate some traps all stations
 - it is popular to get firewood during these events, do we want to promote that? Not so many fallen madrones right now, many standing.
 - are there any clubhouse projects?
 - work on 5-stand shooting stations


- Card Return Box:
