

PREDATOR SCARIFIER

OVERVIEW

A commercial grade lawn scarifier built for serious turf renovation.

- Cutting: 460 mm (18"), 32 pivoting hardened steel blades
- Cutting Depth: -3.0 to +0.5 cm
- Engine: 7.5 HP GB225, 4-stroke
- Fuel: Unleaded petrol | Tank: 4.2 L
- Weight: ~65 kg
- Best For: Buffalo, Couch, Zoysia, Kikuyu lawns

BEFORE YOU START

Safety Gear

 Safety Boots, Eye Protection, and Hearing Protection

Pre-Use Checks

- 1. Read the User Guide
- 2. Ensure the fuel tank is filled with unleaded petrol (provided)
- 3. Inspect for loose parts or damage
- 4. Clear or mark any obstacles such as stones, toys, or irrigation equipment

WARNINGS / DO NOT

- Operate on wet or slippery lawns
- O Use on slopes exceeding a 15-degree incline
- \(\subseteq \text{Leave the engine running unattended} \)
- Nefuel while the engine is running or hot
- Operate without using safety gear

PRN TIPS

- Pass Direction: Scarify in straight lines, overlapping slightly. If required, go over the area twice at different angles.
- Lawn Prep: Mow the lawn short (around 20mm) before scarifying for better results.

HOW TO USE

Starting the Engine

- 1. Open the fuel valve, set choke to 'ON' (if cold)
- 2.Set throttle to ¾ or full and ensure the kill switch is on
- 3. Pull starter cord firmly until the engine starts
- 4. Gradually move choke to run once engine is running smoothly

Adjusting Depth

1.Start shallow and increase depth as needed based on thatch level

Operating the Scarifier

- 1. Squeeze the blade handle to engage this will activate and begin driving the scarifier
- 2. Engage blades only on turf, avoid hard ground
- 3. Walk at a steady pace and avoid turning with blades engaged

AFTER USE

Cleaning

- Let engine cool before brushing off debris
- Avoid using water to prevent rust

Maintenance

• Check for loose parts and top up fuel if required

Storage and Transport

- Store dry, indoors, away from direct sunlight
- Ensure blades are raised off the ground
- Secure during transport to prevent movement
