Reminders for Auxiliaries

It is the duty of the Auxiliary Secretary to file the Installation Report in MALTA preferably by **June 30**, but no later than July 31. And it is the responsibility of the Auxiliary President to ensure the task is completed. If not filed by the deadline the Department Headquarters must submit a request to National requesting to suspend that Auxiliary.

All Auxiliaries must be bonded by **July 31**.

Instructional Training shall be July 8-9 at the Ramada Conference Center, 1450 South Atherton Street in State College. This educational 2-day event shall be for the benefit of the Department District Presidents and Program Chairmen. I am looking forward to spending time with each of you.

Our upcoming **Training Workshop** (the former Fall Conference or if you prefer the, Program Leadership Conference) shall be held on August 12-14, also at the Ramada Conference Center. This will be a 2-day training seminar with various topics being introduced, breakout sessions, and several guest speakers. This event has been planned to provide something for **every Auxiliary member**.

I **strongly recommend** that at least one member from each Auxiliary attend. I have asked Jodie Hollinger and Sarah Smith to be the event co-chairmen and they have a full educational and training agenda scheduled. I hope your schedule will allow for you to attend and take advantage of this wonderful learning weekend.

Something new this year will be the **VFW Auxiliary On The Road Training**. The PA VFWA line officers, with assistance from staff, shall be traveling to three locations within PA to provide a full training day addressing subjects such as ***“Is that Audit Correct? What’s your Chain of Command, What’s Those Programs About?”*** We will be at VFW Post 4909, District 11, 401 Main St., Dupont, PA 18641 on Saturday, July 30; on August 14, VFW Post 6631, District 17, 940 US-522, Selinsgrove, PA 17870; and, on August 27, VFW Post 2145, District 19, 603 Liberty St., Clarion, PA 16214. The VFW and VFW Auxiliary **National Convention** will be in Kansas City, Missouri July 15-21. If you are unable to attend, you may watch the VFW Auxiliary 109th National Convention LiveStream. The livestream will conclude on Thursday, July 21, with the election and installation of the 2022-2023 National Officers.

This year our **Council of Administration** meetings will be available via Zoom to those cannot be present. Simply download the Zoom app and call Department Headquarters for the link and additional instructions to connect. All State Officers, including District Presidents, shall be present at each Council of Administration meeting. The Department President shall be the approving authority for any District President’s absence.

THE JACK E. BARGER, SR. MEMORIAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP FUND

INTRODUCTION

A Memorial Nursing Scholarship Fund was established at the 1989 VFW State Convention, held at King of Prussia, PA. This fund was in Memorial of Jack Barger, Sr., Department Commander, 1987-88, who passed away during his term of office.

POLICIES

Candidates for the award will be solicited through the Pennsylvania Nursing Association and its contacts with nursing schools in Pennsylvania. Chairpersons and deans of nursing schools will be asked to submit names of worthy candidates. The recipient(s) will be chosen by means of a lottery conducted by P.N.A. with the VFW State Commander and Barger Scholarship Chairman drawing the name(s).

There are two qualifications placed on the candidate(s) by the VFW: (1) the individual be a veteran or the son or daughter of a veteran; (2) be a resident of Pennsylvania.



HISTORY

A \$500.00 scholarship was awarded in 1990 and over the past 20 years the amount and number of scholarships awarded have increased to six (6) \$1,000.00 scholarships per year.

There have been various fund-raising efforts made over the years but the two main efforts have been requesting donations from VFW posts and auxiliaries and the Nursing Scholarship Golf Scramble.

FUTURE GOALS

Each year give six (6) scholarships. Increase the equity in the fund in order to make the fund self-sustaining. It is believed that an equity of approximately \$150,000 will be required.

With the help of the VFW posts and auxiliaries within Pennsylvania supporting the Golf Scramble by buying advertisements in the program book we will be able to increase the donation for the golf scramble to over \$10,000.00 each year. All money for advertisements in the Golf Scramble program book goes to the scholarship fund. Remember that none of this money supports the golfers participating in the scramble; however, they support the scholarship program.
