

- Individuals, Posts and Districts can only win **one** time in each **contest or category** unless otherwise stated. The Department Membership Team will make the final determination of all Department awards.
- All <u>contest checks</u> will become the <u>property of the Post or District</u> unless <u>otherwise stated</u>. All checks will be made out to the Post or District Quartermaster unless otherwise stated.



Tools to Boost Membership

Silent Recruiter

The silent recruiter is a display that encourages veterans to register to win a flag set courtesy of the VFW, by filling out a coupon and depositing it in a box. To use this tool, select six to ten businesses with high traffic areas in your community. Then, once a month collect the response cards. Hold a drawing to award the flag set. Follow up recruiting the eligible veteran s that filled out a coupon.

Outreach Recruiting

Set up booths at state, county or local fairs, bazaars, shopping malls, super markets, community shows or events. Have well-dressed members man the booths with flags and membership information of interest to veterans. You may also use this venue to promote the many civic, patriot and youth programs sponsored by the VFW. You may even wish to include the Auxiliary in this outreach recruiting effort.

Posters

Make up posters with your Post name, address and phone number and place in the local stores and businesses.

Periodicals

Offer to make the State and National publications available for the waiting rooms of professional offices—doctors, dentists, lawyers, etc.—in your town. Place a membership application in the publication.

Public Service TV/Radio/Cable Network

Advertise your Post. Tell the people you are going to have a Memorial Day Service, Veterans Day Service, Loyalty Day program or other Post or Auxiliary event that would attract community members. Remember, everyone is welcome. Get the word out through Public Service Announcements mailed for fazed to TV and radio stations. Call News Directors or Editors at your local stations for information about submitting Public Service Announcements.

Tools to Boost Membership

Post Open House

Have an open house at your Post with your officers, and invite all veterans and their families from the surrounding community. Maybe you can sponsor a free buffet or dinner for local troops or military units that are departing to or returning from overseas deployment.

General Networking

Ask your relatives, friends, neighbors and co-workers if they are veterans eligible to join the VFW or Auxiliary. You may wish to cross reference the membership of your Post and the Auxiliary to see that you have recruited every eligible member.

National Guard and Reserve Outreach

Visit the armory in your area; set up a display table or booth during a training weekend. Coordinate with the National Military Service Program (NMS) established by National. Participate in the Adopt a Unit Program. Support the Military Assistance Program.

Welcome Wagon

Business people welcome new neighbors to the area. Put a message and/or gift with your Post name and location with the presents the new people receive. This might even include invitations to post community events or post sponsored social events and fundraisers.

Membership Mission

To recruit, retain, and mentor a stable membership base, including all generations of veterans.

To cultivate a membership that is well versed in institutional knowledge and actively involved at all levels of the organization and in the local community. To establish Posts with a strong tradition of service, leadership, and community outreach.

Introduction

For the past several years, the VFW has been relatively successful in recruiting members aged 39 and younger. The only way to make this success permanent is to retain those members, recover past members, and recruit new members. We must improve the way we communicate with our members at all levels of the organization. Does your Post, District, State or Department have a newsletter, email, or an outreach team that visits fellow members? In many cases, we have lost touch with our members. We need to know who they are and what their needs are. Let us get back to basics—our first priority is taking care of our members and the veteran community as a whole.

Membership Goals

- 1. Build a strong organization for the future.
- 2. Work together to achieve the VFW's goals. The VFW National Headquarters staff is here to assist in coordinating programs, developing new membership initiatives and building awareness among our membership and the entire veteran community.

Membership Objectives

- Recruit new and recover unpaid members
- Retain and mentor existing membership
- Develop new Posts and revitalize existing Posts
- Increase Life Membership
- Increase Legacy Life Membership

Retention Defined

Although retention is <u>not</u> a prerequisite for the All-American program, it is extremely important to understand how retention is derived and the important role retention plays in accomplishing growth. The number of paid annual members in your Post on July 1 is the ensuing year's "prior year total." One more new or reinstated member is required to make up for each prior year annual member the Post fails to retain.

Your Post retention is derived from six types of payment components based on your prior year total of annual members:

- A prior year annual member pays his or her annual membership dues.
- A prior year annual member pays the life membership installment fee.
- A prior year annual member pays for life membership dues.
- A prior year annual member transfers to another Post and pays his or her annual membership dues.
- A prior year annual member transfers to another Post and pays the life membership installment fee.
- A prior year annual member transfers to another Post and pays life membership dues.

Life Membership Amnesty

All life members who are reported deceased between July 1, 2018 and August 31, 2018, will be removed from the Post rolls and the Post's prior year membership count will be adjusted accordingly.

Recruiter of the Year

The VFW member who signs up the greatest number of new and/or reinstated annual members greater than 250 by July 1, 2019, will be awarded:

- A \$1,000 stipend to be used toward attending the VFW National Convention.
- Reserved seating at the VFW National Convention joint opening session.
- Distinctive cap, citation, and name badge.
- Commander-in-Chief's Crystal Eagle.

New Post Development Department Award

For each new Post chartered, the Department Quartermaster will receive:

 A \$250 credit from the VFW Store to be used towards necessary materials for the new Post.


